

TUCKER UNIVERSITY *V Block*

Put your flying geese on the right track by pointing them in the correct direction. Learn the simple secrets to creating crisp, clean units effectively and quickly. This method can be applied to any pattern that requires flying geese units.

Fabric Preparation

Unit 1:

Fabric A: Cut (1) 5" strip x WOF

Fabric B: Cut (1) 5" strip x WOF

Unit 2:

Fabric A: Cut (4) 5" squares

Fabric B: Use remainder from Unit 1 blocks 5" strip

Unit 3:

Fabric A: Cut (4) 5" squares

Fabric B: Use remainder from Unit 1 blocks 5" strip

Unit 4:

Fabric A: Cut (4) 5" squares

Fabric B: Cut (1) 5" strip x WOF

Fabric C: Cut (4) 2-3/4" squares

Unit 5:

Fabric A: Cut (4) 5" squares

Fabric B: Use remainder from Unit 4-5 strip

Fabric C: Use (4) 2-3/4" squares

Supplies Needed

- 80/12 Sharp Needles
- V Block and Quilters Magic Wand

Sewing Basket Supplies

- Sewing machine (*including power cord and foot pedal!*)
- Rotary cutter and various rulers
- Pins
- Sewing machine needles
- Seam ripper
- Thread
- Tape measure
- Marking pencil
- Wonder Clips
- Snips and medium scissors
