TASTING NOTE:

This dry style of Rosé is fresh and lively with berry fruit aromas and floral hints combining with a soft, silky mouthfeel. The palate shows hints of strawberries and cream perfectly balanced with fruit sweetness and a crisp, refreshing finish.

WINEMAKER'S NOTE:

The grapes were picked from a single vineyard, crushed and left on skins for 8 hours to enhance the flavour and release the vibrant colour, before being pressed.

VINTAGE NOTE:

2020 will be remembered for small quantities of high quality fruit. A cold and wet November lead to poor flowering and very low bunch numbers. In contrast to the rest of Australia, our region was disease, drought and smoke taint free.
