TASTING NOTE:

Hints of dark chocolate and vanilla aromas greet you in the glass. This develops into blackberry and cassis with a hint of spice. The palate is full and luscious with good palate weight and a nice dusting of oak. The smooth but present tannin completes this wine with power and prestige. Will complex and age well over the next 10 years.

WINEMAKER'S NOTE:

From the south-facing slope of our Wrattenbully vineyard. This allows for slower ripening and concentration of flavour. Matured for 28 months in new American and used French oak Hogsheads.

VINTAGE NOTE:

A warm October and November advanced bud-burst and flowering by about two weeks earlier than average. Mild conditions in March allowed for a slower finish to the season and ensured enough time for tannins to ripen and flavour to develop.
