### 5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

# **Extinguishing Media:**

Carbon dioxide, foam, dry chemical Do not use a direct water jet.

#### **Combustion Products:**

CO/CO<sub>2</sub>, Smoke

#### Special Protective Equipment:

Avoid inhalation of smoke and fumes. In case of insufficient ventilation wear suitable respiratory equipment.

### 6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

#### **Personal Precautions:**

Gloves and eye protection should be worn when handling spillages. Avoid flames or other potential sources of ignition.

Avoid skin/eye contact and inhalation of vapour.

Good personal washing routines should be followed after accidental release. Ensure adequate ventilation in working areas following accidental release.

#### **Environmental Precautions:**

Do not allow discharge into drains, soil or any aquatic environment.

# Spillage:

Absorb spillages on porous inert material such as earth, sand or vermiculite and dispose of in accordance with local regulations.

Large spillages should be contained by the use of sand or another inert material, transferred to a suitable container and recovered or disposed of in accordance with local regulations.

# **General Handling Precautions:**
