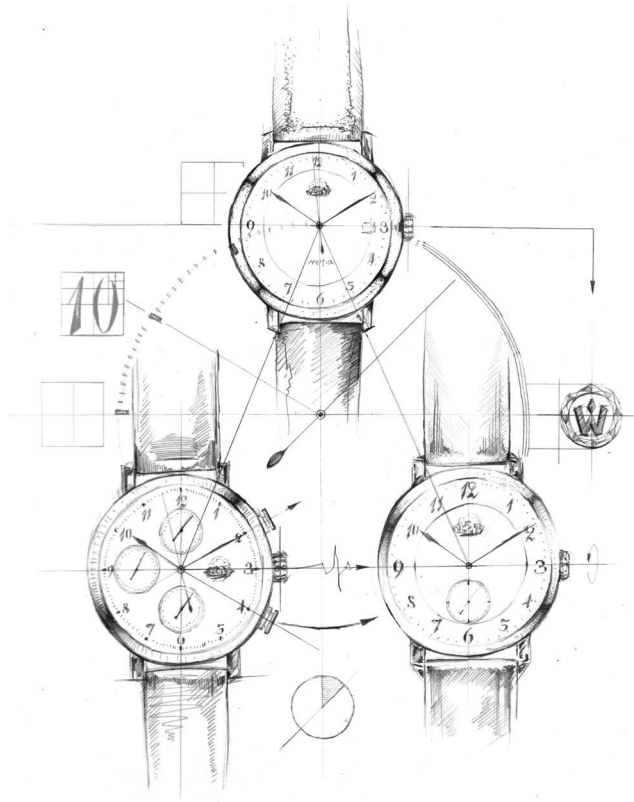
The first models after the relaunch of Eugen Wegner watches, revived in 2020 in Hamburg, Germany.

The beginning of a family's business journey.

Already at a young age, Eugen Wegner, an award-winning young watchmaker, opens his first workshop in Gdańsk. He was the great-great-grandfather of today's team. With the support of his wife Eugen Wegner manages to rapidly grow the business and new workshops and stores are opened in several other Prussian cities. In the second half of the 20th century, branches opened up in Lübeck, Hamburg and Duisburg, among others.

Hevelius bears the name of a pocket watch from the original Eugen Wegner product line. An elegant model combining precision and comfort, it features classic styling based on the rediscovered pocket watch's design elements. Hevelius is a suitable choice for any occasion.

Our watchmakers work with the finest materials at our Hamburg manufactory. The in-house team refines classic Swiss movements to the highest level of precision. These refinements include technically demanding craftsmanship such as grinding and engraving the rotors and polishing and bluing the screws. Each watch is made in our own workshop, completely assembled in Hamburg, and undergoes strict quality control testing before shipping.
