

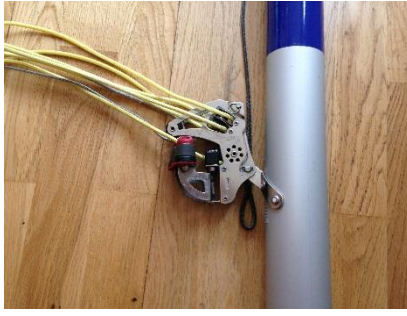

The rigging of the downhaul avoids extra forces on the kicker fitting and is rigged without having to undo any pins or tie knots.

**Step 1 – Start by passing the loop on the end of the primary through the sail cringle.**



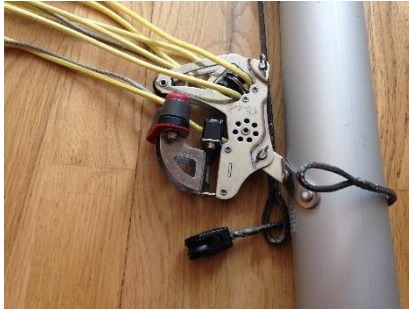
**Step 2 – Pull the loop down to just below the kicker tang**



**Step 3 – Pass the eye on the end of the small assembly through the primary line loop.**



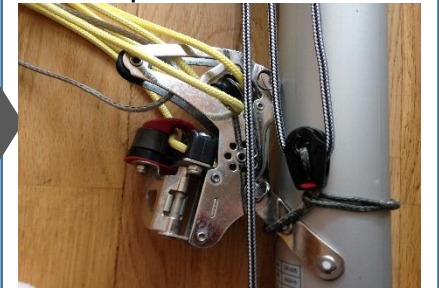
**Step 4 – Take the eye around the mast below the kicker tang .**



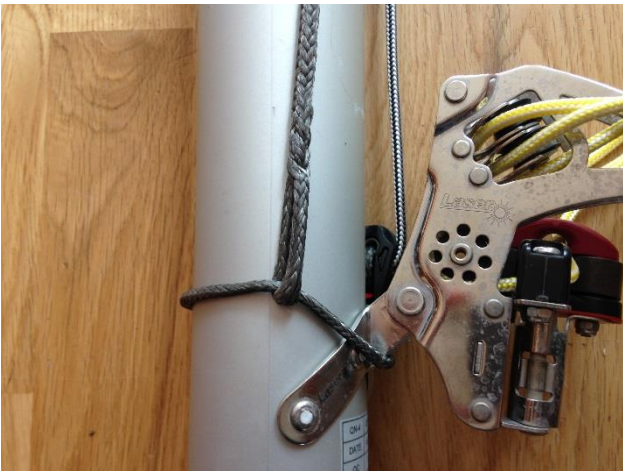
**Step 5 – Then pass the block through the eye**



**Step 6 – Thread the coloured control line from the block at the sail through the block at the kicker tang and back up to the block at the sail.**
