
Quick Assembly Instructions


The dimensions of the case shown here is a general example. Your case will probably have different sized panels. Your case should have two panels labeled front/back, two panels labeled side, one panel labeled top, and one panel labeled baseplate. Some smaller cases like our minifigure cases aren't labeled but you can match shape of the panels in the illustrations below to pick them out. Most, but not all, our cases also include 4 metal connector cubes and 12 screws.

First remove the protective film from all the panels. It may be plastic typically either blue, white, or transparent, or it may be brown paper. This film used to protect the acrylic panels from scratches during manufacturing and shipping. Using a fingernail at a corner usually does the trick to get started. Inspect each panel and let us know immediately if any part is damaged or defective.




Place the baseplate on a solid smooth surface and place one of the case panels labeled front/back into the baseplate slots.

If your case comes with metal connector cubes, be sure the screw holes in the panel are at the top.




Place a side panel into the base plate slots and connect it to the groves of the panel you just placed in the baseplate as well.

If your case has metal connector blocks and screws, connect both panels together inside the top corner of the panels. *Be sure NOT to overtighten the screws*



Work your way around the baseplate with the second front/back panel and secure with a metal connect and two screws (if applicable).



Install the second side panel and secure with a metal connector and two screws (if applicable)





Finally, place the top panel and secure with 4 screws (if applicable).
