

- Before removing the unit from the toilet bowl, disconnect the power plug first.
- Do not connect other electrical appliances to the same power socket connected to the unit.


- Never block the air openings of the product or place it on a soft surface, such as a bed or couch, where the air openings may be blocked.

INSTALLATION



Installation Procedure

- Read the instructions carefully before installing. Plug in electrical cord only after the rest
- of installation is completed.
- Shut-off water supply and disconnect the toilet supply hose.
 - Close the shut-off valve at the wall. Flush toilet tank completely to empty it. Then, disconnect the toilet supply hose where it connects to the toilet tank fill valve, NOT at the shut-off valve.
 - If your toilet is skirted and you cannot access the toilet's fill valve, contact us to purchase an alternate t-valve.
- Remove the existing toilet seat
 - Remove the old toilet seat. It's usually fastened via nuts underneath the bowl.
 - It's a good idea to save your old toilet seat in case you need it again later.





IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

WARNING To reduce the risk of burns, electrocution, fire or injury to persons.

- Never use while sleeping or drowsy.
- Never drop or insert any object into any opening or hose.
- Do not use outdoors, or operate where aerosol(spray) products are being used or where oxygen is being administered.
- Do not pour or spray water on to the unit.
- Do not use steam cleaner.
- Keep the unit away from fires or inflammable substance.
- Do not connect to the industrial water supplies.
- Caution against low temperature burns.
- New hose-sets supplied with the appliance are to be used and that old hose-sets should not be reused.

CAUTION To reduce the risk of injury to persons or damage to the product or the property.

- Do not place heavy objects or step on the unit.
- It may cause product damage or injury.
- When cleaning the unit, do not use any harsh chemicals like bleach, ammonia or alcohol based cleaners. Clean the unit with warm water and mild soap. Natural disinfectants like vinegar may also be used.

- Do not slam down the lid. It may cause product defect.
- Do not lean on the lid.
- It may cause product defect.
- When not in use for a long period of time (more than 2-3 months), disconnect the power plug and drain the water tank.

Tank water may be contaminated and cause skin troubles.

- Do not twist or pull the connection hoses.
- It may affect water supply or cause water leakage
- Do not cover up the warm air outlet or insert hands or other objects. It may cause burn or electric shock.
- Do not operate the unit during product malfunction.

Disconnect the power plug and call the authorized service center. It may cause fire or electric shock if the unit is operated while it is out of order.

Connect T-valve

- Install the T-valve to your toilet's fill valve underneath the tank, NOT at the shut-off valve.
- Ensure the rubber cone washer is present at the top and pointed up toward the toilet tank. This connection typically does not need teflon tape.
- Reconnect the toilet supply hose to the bottom of the T-valve




Lock the mounting plate into the seat.

- Place the Mounting Bolts into the Bolt Brackets as shown to the right.



- Position the bolts and brackets in the Mounting Plate as shown below. Slide the Mounting Plate with Bolts/Brackets into the rear of the bidet unit in the direction shown below.
- The Mounting Plate should slide into grooves on the underside of the bidet. Keep pushing it in until it locks into place with an audible click.




GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING Improper use of the grounding plug can result in risk of electric shock.

This product is for use with a 110/120v circuit and at least 15amps and a GFCI (ground fault circuit interrupter) outlet. Do not use this product with an ungrounded outlet.

GFCI outlets are required in waterborne environments (like bathrooms).

The product does not require a dedicated circuit.




Install the bidet onto the toilet bowl.

- Pick up the bidet seat with mounting bolts protruding from the bottom. Place it onto your toilet bowl and align the bolts through the bolt holes of the bowl.
- Arrange the Rubber Packing, Washer, and Mounting Nut as shown to the right.
- From under the toilet bowl, fasten the Mounting Nuts to each Mounting Bolt as shown below. Be sure that the Rubber Packing and Washer are arranged on top of the



Connect the supply hose to the bidet.

- Connect the Supply Hose from the T-valve to the bidet inlet located underneath the side control panel.
- Once all connections are tight, slowly open the shut-off valve and check for leaks.
- If you find a leak, shut off the water. Make sure that all rubber washers and o-rings are properly seated. Re-tighten and then turn the water on again.



Operation check

- . Connect the power plug into electrical outlet
- 2. Wait for the bidet to power on and run through startup cycle.
- 3. Sit on the seat with skin contact. Test functions
- 4. Heated seat and warm water features will need a few minutes to heat up.






Using the POWER SAVE Feature

- There are 2 power saving eco modes to save energy while the seat is idle.
 Press the button once to activate Mode 1 (green LED): This mode will maintain the selected water and seat temperatures for 30 minutes after standing up. After that, water heater will turn OFF, and seat temperature will reduce to 86F. Both water and seat heating will turn OFF if idle for 24 hours.

MAINTENANCE

- Press the button twice to activate Mode 2 (red LED). This will turn both the water and seat heaters OFF until someone sits down.
- If a user sits down while either power saving mode is on, the water and seat heaters will turn on and work up to the preset temperatures. This will take about 5 minutes.
- When user stands up, the water heater and seat heaters will automatically return to power save

IMPORTANT

- If you prefer a consistently warm seat and heated water each time you sit down, we would advise you to turn off the power saving modes.
- To turn off the power saving modes, press POWER SAVE until the LED is off.

Cleaning the Nozzle

- Use a soft cloth or toothbrush to clean the nozzle.
- Do not use abrasive, volatile, or acid/alkaline detergents and chemicals. It may corrode the nozzle.

Nozzle Clean (Automatic)

Press the NOZZLE CLEAN button while nobody is seated to activate a 2 minute automatic self cleaning function.

Nozzle Clean (Manual)

- Press and hold the NOZZLE CLEAN button while nobody is seated for 5 seconds. The nozzle will
- come out and stay out for manual cleaning. Brush the nozzle tip with a soft brush and wipe the nozzle with a cloth. Press STOP when done
- * Do not pull out or push the nozzle forcibly.
- * Nozzle clean function does not work when seat occupied


Removing the Bidet Seat

The seat release tab is a small tab on the underside of the unit (same side as electrical cord)

Press in and hold this seat tab to release the bidet seat from the catch plate. Slide whole unit forward toward front of bowl to remove.

Screen Filter Cleaning

- Close the water shut-off valve at the wall.
- Disconnect the water supply hose. Take the screen filter out and clean it with a soft brush.
- Return the filter after cleaning and reconnect the water supply hose.



Cleaning of Unit Body

- Exterior surface of unit is made of plastic material, which may be damaged by scrubber chemicals, bleach, alcohol based cleaners, etc.
- Wine the surface with a soft damp cloth. Do not spray water directly onto the surface
- Be careful of not dropping any chemical detergents of toilet cleaner on the water supply hose. Risk of the hose damage



Draining Water Tank

- Unplug the bidet from the power outlet
- Close the water shut-off valve.
- Press/hold the seat release tab and slide the unit forward and off the catch plate
- Use a coin to open the drain plug


