THE WORLD

Card Game

Contents: 90 Cards

Object of the Game: Be the first player to collect 6 Cards from at least 4 different continents.

Set Up: Shuffle the Cards and place them face down in a single deck in the middle of all players.

How to Play:

1. The youngest player begins the game as the Reader and draws the top Card from the deck.
2. The Reader then reads the name of the continent and the question on the Card to the player to the left of the Reader (Player 1).
3. If Player 1 answers the question correctly, that player collects the Card. If Player 1 answers incorrectly, the Card is set aside in a discard pile and Player 1's turn is over.

4. Play continues with Player 1 taking the role of the Reader and the player to the left answering the question on the Card.

Antarctica Cards:

When a Reader draws an Antarctica Card, Player 1 must perform the action as written on the Card. Once players have performed the action on an Antarctica Card, the Antarctica Card is discarded and play passes clockwise. Antarctica Cards do not count toward a player's hand or number of continents.

Winning the Game:

Play continues until one player has collected 6 Cards from at least 4 different continents. (*EX: Player 1 has collected 2 Cards from Europe, 1 Card from Africa, 2 Cards from South America and 1 Card from Asia.*) That player is the winner!
