


PARTS OF GTS MAX EVO

ASSEMBLING YOUR ESCOOTER


CHARGING



Firmly connect the wires inside the handle and the stem. Slide the handle onto the stem. Be aware of the correct orientation.


Install four screws (two each side) with hex wrench

Verify if your Mearth Scooter powers on and off.






CHARGING PORT



INSERT THE CHARGE PLUG.




CLOSE THE CHARGE PORT COVER WHEN FINISHED.

REMINDER:


Do not connect the charger if the charging cable is wet. Your Mearth scooter is fully charged when the LED is on GREEN and RED still charging. CHARGING: 3.5 HRS - 6 HOURS TO FULLY CHARGE





GENERAL OPERATION.

YOUR NEW GTS MAX IS FITTED WITH AN ALL-NEW, EASY TO READ HUD.



- 1. Turn the **ignition key** clockwise then press and hold the **"on/off"** button until you see the display activate the e-scooter to turn it off, just simply turn the **ignition key** counterclockwise.
- 2. The GTS Max is in **dual motor** function when turned on. You can change it to a **single motor** function by pressing **single/dual** motor button.
- 3. To change gears, simply press the "MODE" button.
- 4. Pressing **eco-turbo** will give extra power and speed when in higher gear & in dual motor function.
- 5. Press the "on/off" button to display the trip meter, battery voltage, and odometer.
- 6. To activate the **dual rear light**, press and hold the **"MODE"** button for 3 seconds until you see the rear light icon on the LCD.
- 7. You can use the USB port at the back of the LCD for your other devices.
- 8. To open front light, press the light button beside the horn button at the left side of the handlebar.

HOW TO REMOVE THE SPEED LIMIT FOR GTS MAX EVO

- 1. Press the Power and Mode button at the same time to show the P settings
- 2. Go to P8 by pressing the Power button
- 3. Once your on P8, press Mode Button
- 4. Change the P8 setting to 70 by pressing power button (70 is the max)
- 5. To return to the main screen, press the power and mode button again at the same time

REMINDERS & MAINTENANCE

- ♠ DO NOT ride the scooter in the rain
- ↑ DO NOT ride over speed bumps, thresholds, or other bumps at HIGH SPEED
- Match your head when passing through doorways
- ↑ Watch your speed when traveling downhill. Use both brakes together when traveling at high speed.
- ♠ DO NOT press the throttle when walking with the scooter.
- ♠ Avoid contacting obstacles with the tire/wheel.
- ▲ DO NOT carry heavy objects on the handlebar.
- ↑ DO NOT ride on public road, motorways, or highways
- ⚠ Do not rotate the handle violently while driving at high speed
- ⚠ Do NOT ride through puddles or other bodies of water deeper than 1 inch (2cm)
- ↑ The Mearth Scooter is for one rider only. Do not ride double or carry any passengers. DO NOT carry a child while riding the escooter.

Cleaning and Storage

Use a soft, wet cloth to wine the mainframe clean. Hard-to-remove dirt can be scrubbed with a toothbrush and toothpaste, and cleaned with a soft, wet cloth. Scratches on the plastic part can be polished with fine grit abrasive paper.

NOTE:

Do not wash your Mearth Scooter with alcohol, gasoline, acetone, or other corrosive/volatile solvents. These substances may damage the appearance and internal structure of your Mearth Scooter. Do not wash your Mearth Scooter with a power washer or hose.

Make sure the Mearth Scooter is powered OFF, the charging cable is unplugged, and the rubber cap on the charge port is tightly sealed before cleaning; other you may damage the electronics components

Store your Mearth GTS MAX Scooter in a cool, dry place. Do not store it outdoors for extended periods of time. Exposure to sunlight and temperature extremes (both hot and cold) will accelerate the aging process of the plastic components and may reduced battery life.

Battery Pack Maintenance

Do not store or charge the battery at temperatures outside the stated limits (see Specifications). Do not puncture the battery.

Refer to your local laws and regulations regarding battery recycling and/or disposal.


A well-maintained battery can perform well even after many miles of riding. Charge the battery after each ride and avoid draining the battery completely. When used at room temperature (70% F {22 C}) the battery range and performance are at its best; whereas using it at temperature below 32F (oC) can decrease range and performance. Typically at -4 F (-20 C) range can be half that of the same battery at 70 F (22C). Battery range will recover when the temperature rises.

NOTE:

Typically, a fully charged battery should retain charge for 120-180 days in Standby mode. A low-power battery should retain for 30-60 days in Standby Mode. Remember to charge the battery after each use. Completely draining the battery may cause permanent damage to the battery. Electronics inside the battery record the charge-discharge condition of the battery damage caused by over-discharge or under-discharge will not be covered by the Limited Warranty.

WARNING:

Do not ride the ambient temperature outside the machine's preferred temperature (See Specifications) because low or high temperature will limit the maximum power or torque. Doing so could cause personal injury

 - o 2 years of warranty from the date of purchase for the frame of any electric scooter model from Mearth
 - 1 year of warranty from the date of purchase for the motor, battery, main body, and controller of any electric scooter model from Mearth
- 2. Repair within 30 days is covered under Mearth's warranty. Repair fees apply after 30 days of purchase except for the frame, motor, and battery.
