



1 Assembly

- 1. Chomp Unit with lid
- 2. One pair of gloves
- 3. One tap + two washers + one nut
- 4. One separator for leechate
- 5. One stand
- 6. One packet of Remix Powder
- 7. Microbes and Neem 30 gm each

Separator for leechate with diagonal cut on one side



1 tap + 2 washers + 1 nut

Fix tap on bucket in hole provided. One washer comes outside on the face of the bucket and one inside face of the bucket - locked in with the nut inside

In case a yellow breather has come off - fix into the hole on the unit



Row composting step by step

2 Placement

3 Chomps for 3 kgs per day

Place Chomps in a row in a location not exposed to too much rain (recommended flat surface, corner of terrace or balcony or garden) Safe from pets



3 Preparation

Daily Dump has two kinds of Carbon additive - Remix Powder and Compost Maker

Add 4 fists of Remix Powder / Compost Maker at the base of all Chomps before you begin using. This is to absorb leechate



4 For smell free composting

Add 3-4 fistfuls of Remix powder into the kitchen waste container



Mix the powder into the waste well!



Put kitchen waste into Chomp 1



Cover what you put in with a layer of Remix powder. Cover again with a sheet of newspaper like an inner lid to keep out fruitflies

5 Daily Activity

Lift the cover sheet of newspaper from Chomp 1 in the row

Repeat steps 1-3



Cover with the same newspaper again

6 Keep it going

As you keep filling Chomp 1, you may find white fungus, this is an indicator of effective composting.



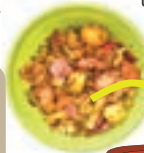
When Chomp 1 is full, stir well add microbes, neem. One spoon each. Mix in well.

Add more Remix powder if pile is wet.
Add water if pile is dry.
Pile needs to be moist.

Wipe moisture off the lid daily to avoid your pile getting too wet.



Now start filling waste in Chomp 2. When that is full, fill Chomp 3, so on till you reach the last Chomp in the row.



Once in a week stir each Chomp and correct moisture if necessary. Drain excess leechate.

7 Harvesting

By the time the last pot is full the materials in Chomp 1 should be composted and ready to harvest. Remove contents and store. Prepare Chomp 1 and begin putting in fresh waste following the process as before.

You can also use a bucket with holes to store nearly done

For best results Keep moist for another 2 months before using.



Unless you sieve you will not get a powder consistency of compost. Sieve if you like and put the large pieces back into fresh waste. They will compost over time.

This instruction sheet explains the process for 3 Chomps in a Row composting



For more homes you will need more than 3 Chomps in a row. Shown on the top is a possible filling routine with Chomps. (ex: For 6 kgs fill into 2 Chomps at a time and you will need 6 of them)



Are you adding Remix Powder Daily?

Do not forget to add this daily.



1 Bad Smell

Bad smell indicates your pile is soggy and **needs more Remix Powder**. Mix in well.

Optimum composting does not smell bad. You need to add proper qty of **Remix Powder DAILY**



2 Leachate



If too much liquid builds up in your composter, it means you have put less Remix Powder. **Add lots more Remix and mix in well**, till **all units** have no excess liquid.

3 Worms, Bugs

Usually in a week you will begin to see small white worms. These are the larvae of the black soldier fly. There will be other bugs too.

These are good for composting and are harmless.

Control their population by adding 1 table spoon of **Neem powder** and mixing in well once a week. Increase the heat of the pile by adding 1 teaspoon of **microbes daily**. This will reduce the bugs.

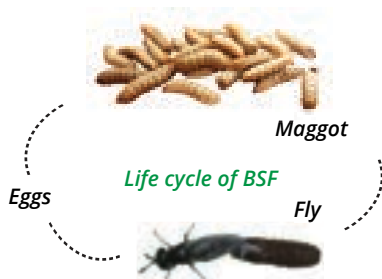
Also keep aeration clear - **unclog the holes** in the breather caps. This will also control bugs. **Use a pin**.



Unclog holes

If worms come out of the composter, sweep them into a dust pan and put back in your composter or under a tree. Birds love them.

Mature maggots become **black**. **Soldier flies** that emerge are **harmless**.



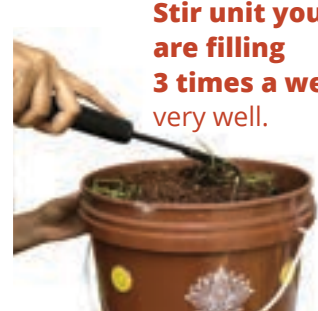
4 Moisture



Composting naturally creates heat so water condenses inside the plastic units.

Wipe this excess moisture from under the lid daily.

5 Stir



Stir unit you are filling 3 times a week very well.

No need to stir other units once kept aside.

6 Keep fruit flies away



Don't forget to **cover your compost pile** with paper which helps control fruit flies. This will get wet and soggy. Tear and mix in with the pile. Use a fresh sheet.

You can also cover **with a thin muslin cloth** and reuse that, in place of newspaper.

7 Harvested compost

Add more Remix in and store - sieve a month later

Ready to sieve and store for maturation

Add moisture, mix and store for month before sieving



8 It's full!

If all your Chomp units **get full** before **40 days**, you **are generating more than 1 kg of waste per day**

You will need to **invest in another** Chomp as an additional unit.
