

Rules of Play:

• The lottery will take place from January 15 to February 4, 2021 at The Grocery Foundation,

5399 Eglinton Avenue West, Suite 105, Etobicoke, Ontario M9C 5K6 and online at nighttonurture.ca

- All tickets will only be sold to people who are 18 years of age or older.
 - All tickets will only be sold to people who are located in the province of Ontario in accordance with the raffle license.
- Tickets prices are 5 for \$10, 20 for \$20 or 100 for \$50.
- Tickets will be sold using electronic raffle system supplied by Canadian Bank Note Company, Ltd..
- The draw dates will take place on:

o Main 50/50 draw: February 4, 2021 at The Grocery Foundation. Ticket

purchases must be made no later than 12:00PM on February 4, 2021 in order to be

eligible for this main 50/50 draw.

• After buying, patrons will be emailed a receipt with their 50/50 registered numbers from a Random Number Issuing System. No specific numbers can be given as numbers are generated randomly.

• The winning ticket number will be selected by a Random Number Generator (RNG) system from all raffle numbers sold for the draw.

 \cdot The amount of the 50/50 will be monitored on website, and will be 50% of the total sales for that draw.

- The jackpot has been seeded by The Grocery Foundation in the amount of \$5,000.00
- The winning number will be announced on the Night to Nurture website and social media channels.

The winner will also be contacted directly by a representative from The Grocery Foundation by phone and/or email.

• The winner may claim their prize by contacting the The Grocery Foundation at: 416-515-8165 or by email at: admin@groceryfoundation.com. The Grocery Foundation will verify the winning ticket number. The winner will then be awarded the prize amount by cheque. Winners must have the original winning ticket and no copies. All payments will be made by cheque.

• The winning ticket holder has 6 months in which to claim their prize from the date of the draw their ticket was purchased for.

• The winner must provide photo identification and verify their phone number and address in order to claim their prize.

• Once the certified winner is verified, and provides identification with photo ID, they will be given a cheque in the amount of the declared prize which is, at minimum, 50% of the total sales for that draw. If the winner cannot provide photo ID, then the winning proceeds will be held until such identification can be provided.

• In the event that no winner comes forward, the winning ticket number will be saved and held for 6 months. After that time period has elapsed the prize will be donated back to The Grocery Foundation and Kids Help Phone with the approval of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO).
