Do I require an FCC license to operate the radio?	 Yes, an FCC license is required. You can obtain it directly from the FCC at 1-888-CALLFCC (1.888.225.5322) or <u>http://www.fcc.gov</u> and request form 601. Use a frequency coordinator (Recommended). Why should I get an FCC License?	 It protects you from interference from other users without a license. The FCC will assign you a frequency that should be free from use by others in your assigned area, adding a level of privacy and security to your conversations. People that are caught (reported to the FCC) using your licensed frequency without authorization can be fined by the FCC.
How much does a FCC License cost?	 Fee is about \$95 and is good for 10 years. The cost of an FCC coordinator is extra, usually around \$100 for a simple license. Check the FCC website for any updates to fees or for any other questions you may have.
