## TECH TIP

Question	Solution
The programming data will not transfer to the radio from the computer, I keep getting an error code when I click "start".	<ul> <li>There are compatibility issues with Windows 11 and the Prolific Driver needed to transfer the data from the PC to the radio. See separate Tech Tip and update the driver to resolve the issue.</li> <li>Make sure the programming cable is correctly installed between the radio and computer. Un-plug and re-install the cable or replace it if necessary.</li> <li>Make sure the radio has a charged battery and is turned on. (Do not program a radio while in the charger.)</li> <li>Check your COM port. Your computer will automatically assign a COM port to transfer the data from the PC to the radio, but you may need to try a different COM port.</li> <li>Install a USB to Serial Port conversion driver. The programming cable includes this driver and should automatically install on your computer the first time you use it. You can install or update a standard driver, if necessary, from: http://www.prolific.com.tw/US/ShowProduct.aspx?p_id=225&amp;pcid=41</li> </ul>
