

Section A - For bags with peel-away, hook and loop sides



Step 1:

Start by taking a top-down photo of your divider and gear layout for reference when reassembling your bag

Remove all dividers and set aside.

NOTE: If your bag has a zippered liner, continue to Section B Step 2 (next page)

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Step 2:

For bags with peel-away, hook and loop sides

Pull back the inside flap on the side of the bag to reveal a zipper behind the lock.



Step 3:

Using your thumb or a flathead screwdriver, unzip the zipper slider to gain access to the two screwheads on the backside of the lock.

Remove both screws and washers using a Philips head screwdriver. *Set aside the screws and washers for use during reassembly.*

Step 4:

Position the replacement lock over the two mounting holes. Place a washer over either hole in the plastic backing and screw in until snug. Repeat the process with the second screw and washer.

Step 5:

Zip the lock pocket closed, reattach the side panel flap and reinstall the dividers.

Section B - For bags with zippered liners

Step 1:

Start by taking a top-down photo of your divider and gear layout for reference when reassembling your bag (See photo on Section A, previous page).

Remove all dividers and set aside.



Step 2:

For bags with zippered liners

Lift the bottom flap to gain access to the zipper pull and slider.



Step 3:

Unzip the liner *halfway* around the bag to give yourself space to reach the two screwheads on the backside of the lock.



Step 4:

Remove both screws and washers using a Philips head screwdriver. Set aside the screws, washers and plastic backing (when applicable) aside for use during reassembly. Your bag's plastic backing may be permanently attached to the bag.

Step 5:

Position the replacement lock over the two mounting holes. Place a washer over either hole in the plastic backing and screw in until snug. Repeat the process with the second screw and washer.

Step 6:

Zip up the liner making sure to tuck-in the excess zipper tape, fold down the gray flap and reinstalling the dividers.

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Setting TSA Combination Lock



Step 1:

To LOCK the main compartment, push the ends of the zipper sliders HARD into the slots.



Step 2:

To UNLOCK the main compartment, set your combination then push the end buttons INWARD



Step 3:

The lock's combination is pre set from the factory at 0 0 0. To CHANGE the combination, there is a hole on the side of the lock. Push the button IN with a pen until you hear a 'click'.



Step 4:

SET the numbers to your desired combination. Please REMEMBER your new combination!



Step 5:

PUSH both ends inward HARD until you hear a 'click'. Your new combination is now active.



Step 6:

The TSA (Transport Security Administration) lock allows airport personnel to access your bag. Think Tank Photo does not recommend gate-checking your gear, but there may be situations where airport personnel requires entry. Please note that there is no individual key for this bag.
