



SEWING PATTERN #8 – reversible TUB – by Splash Fabric

5x5 base x 8" tall x 6.5" d at top | 2" loops | reversible

Enjoy making our **easy-peasy** reversible **TUBS**. They fit a 4"-6" potted plant, your knitting, bathroom ditties hanging from a hook... Our fabrics are 58" wide so you can cut 2 of these out 2 half-yard pieces of fabric (1 print for each side) and still have some left over for 3 Flat Pouches in the margins.

Warning: these are addictive.

Our Amazing Splash Fabric Laminated Cotton

WIPE 'N' WASH

100% Cotton, Laminated

Splash, Slop, Spill Proof

Durable & Long-Lasting

Water-based urethane laminated cotton CPSIA certified, BPA & Phthalate-free, food-safe. Wipe clean with damp cloth, scrub stains on back side. Machine wash warm okay, hang dry, iron low.

Sewing Notes (RS = Right Sides, RST = Right Sides Together, WST = Wrong Sides Together)

Fear not: Sewing with laminated cotton is easier than it looks.

Standard or heavy thread and Denim needle work well.

Needle suggestion: SCHMETZ NonStick size 100 is even better

Use a longer than normal stitch length. (#3-3.5)

No need to bind or serge cut edges. Laminated cotton won't unravel - it's sealed.

NOTE: Our fabrics are 58" wide. The usable lamination is ~56-57". Tubs, unlike garments, don't care about the warp & weft or stretch. Our fabrics are mostly "tossed" so you can cut them vertically, horizontally, or any way you choose.

Materials

Fabric: 2 pieces of fabric, 21" x 11.25".

For loops: 2 pieces of 4" of string or ribbon or parachute cord. Seal the ends (burn the ends of the nylon).

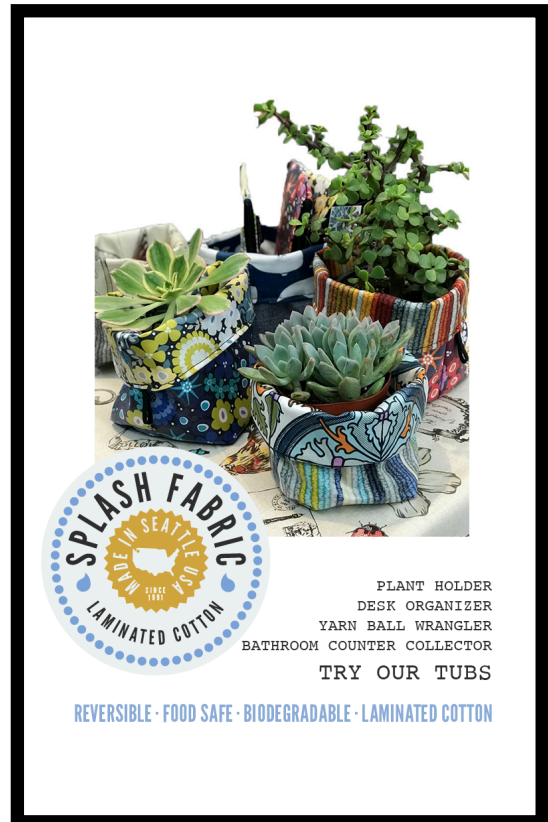
Cut

1. Cut 2 rectangles 21" x 11.25" - Cut 1 of each print to make it reversible!
2. Mark and Cut bottom corners 2.5" and middle bottom 5" x 2.5" as shown.

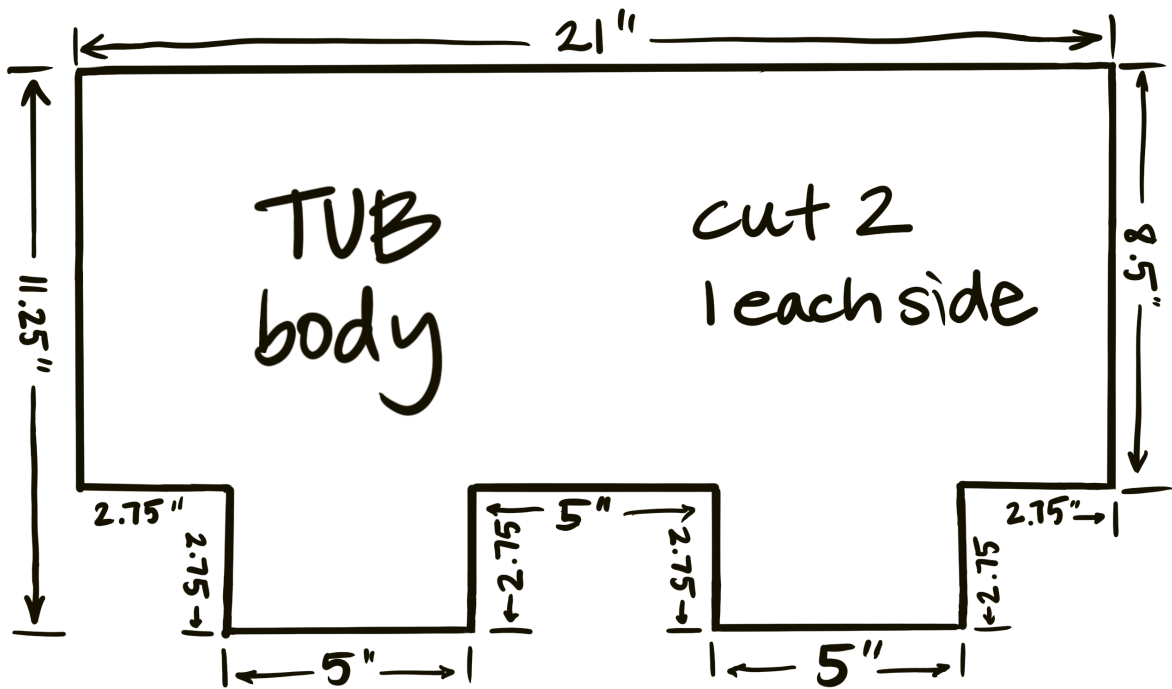
Sew You'll start by making 2 separate tubs, then stitch them together around the top.

1. Fold your rectangle in half, RST, stitch sides, on both inside
2. Stitch bottoms of both the inside and the outside.
3. Open bottom corners, stitch closed - make "box corners" (4 places).
4. Turn 1 tub inside out. Place 1 tub inside the other, WST (Wrong Sides Together) so the right sides are showing. Fold 1/2" down inside at the top. Pin or clip top edges and add loops in. (See photo below) Top Stitch 1/4" from top. Double stitch over loops to secure.

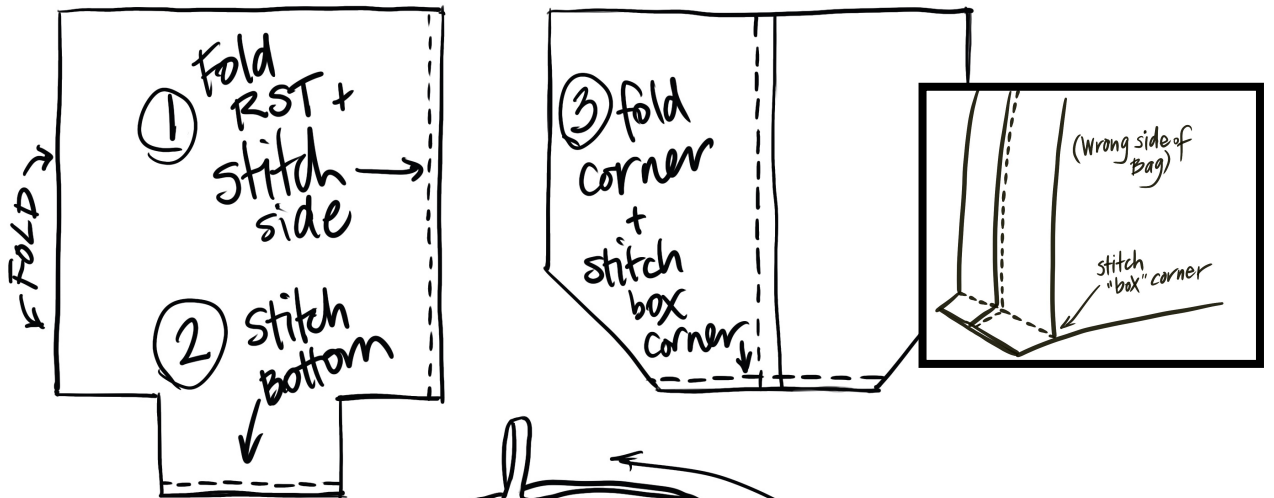
DONE! Now fill it up. Enjoy!



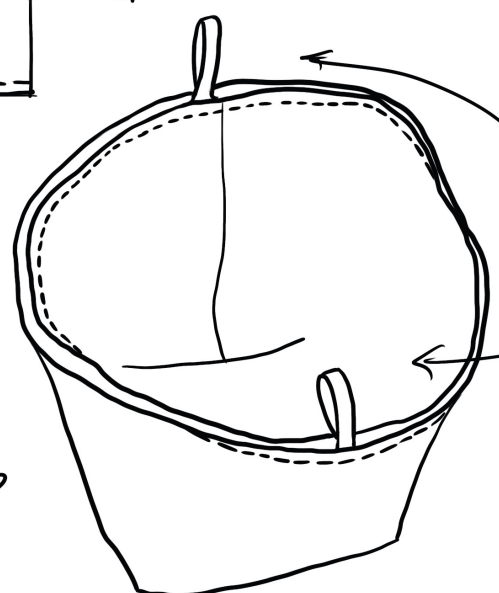
