The QR code to download the app to control the halos is located on the controller.




Once downloaded, with the halos on, navigate to the left most screen on the app.



The controller will show up under my devices. A link next to the name of the controller indicates the controller is connected. A broken link indicates the controller is not connected.

The light bulb can be used to toggle the halos on and off once connected.

Next, navigate to the right most screen on the app.




First, click on Pixels and set the pixels to 1000. The controllers come default with the pixels set low, so if only part of your halo or strip is lighting up, that is why.

If your colors seem off, you can change the pin sequence in this screen as well. Typically the controller works as it should on RGB or GRB settings.



On the main screen, you have a wheel where you can manually set the color to one of your liking. You can set presets by first clicking on a preset, and then changing the color on the wheel.

The brightness can be adjuster via the slider under the color wheel.



Under style there are a ton of different modes to choose from where the halos will rotate in different colors and patterns. The speed can be adjusted at the bottom with the slider. Have fun playing around with it!
