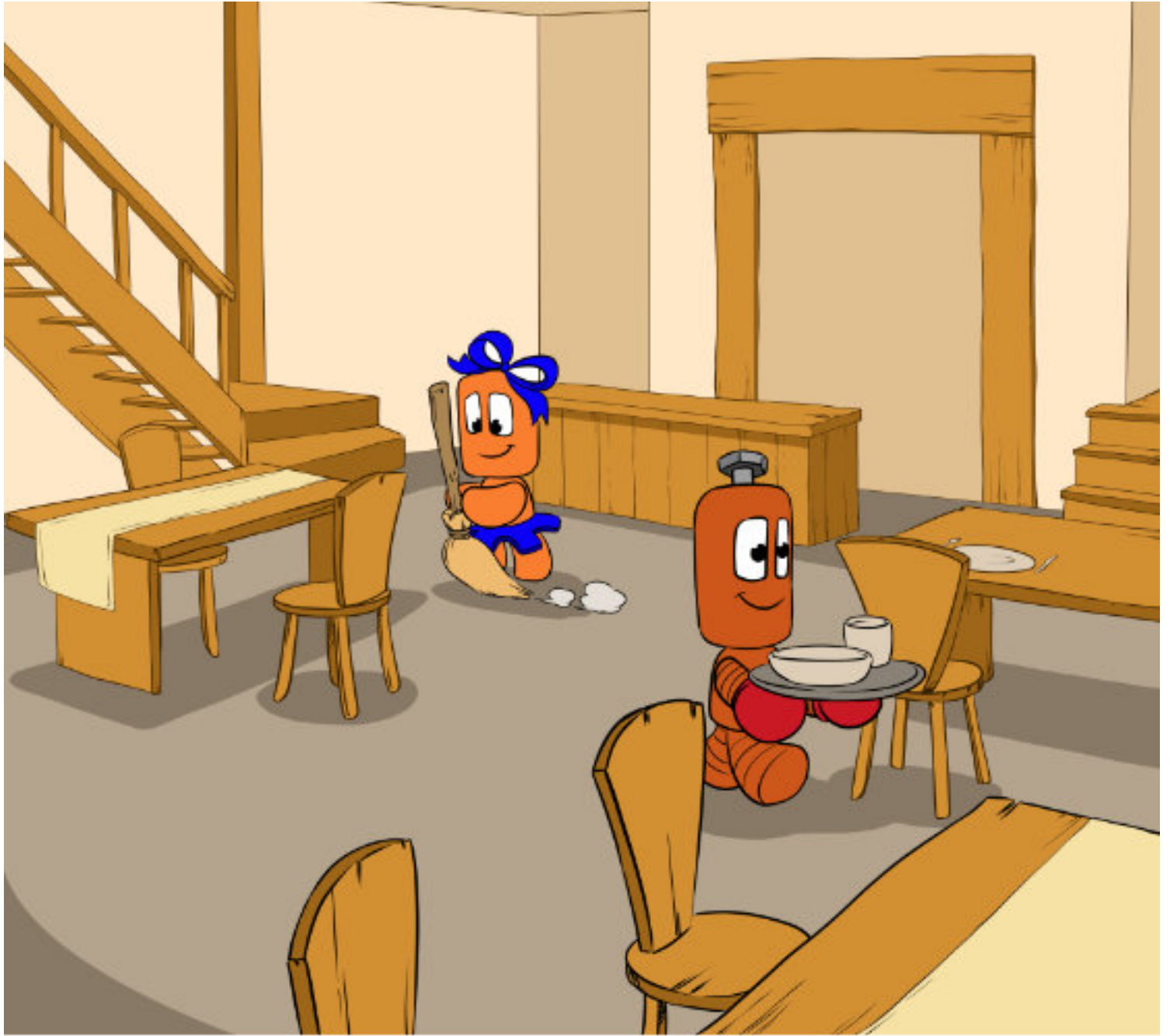

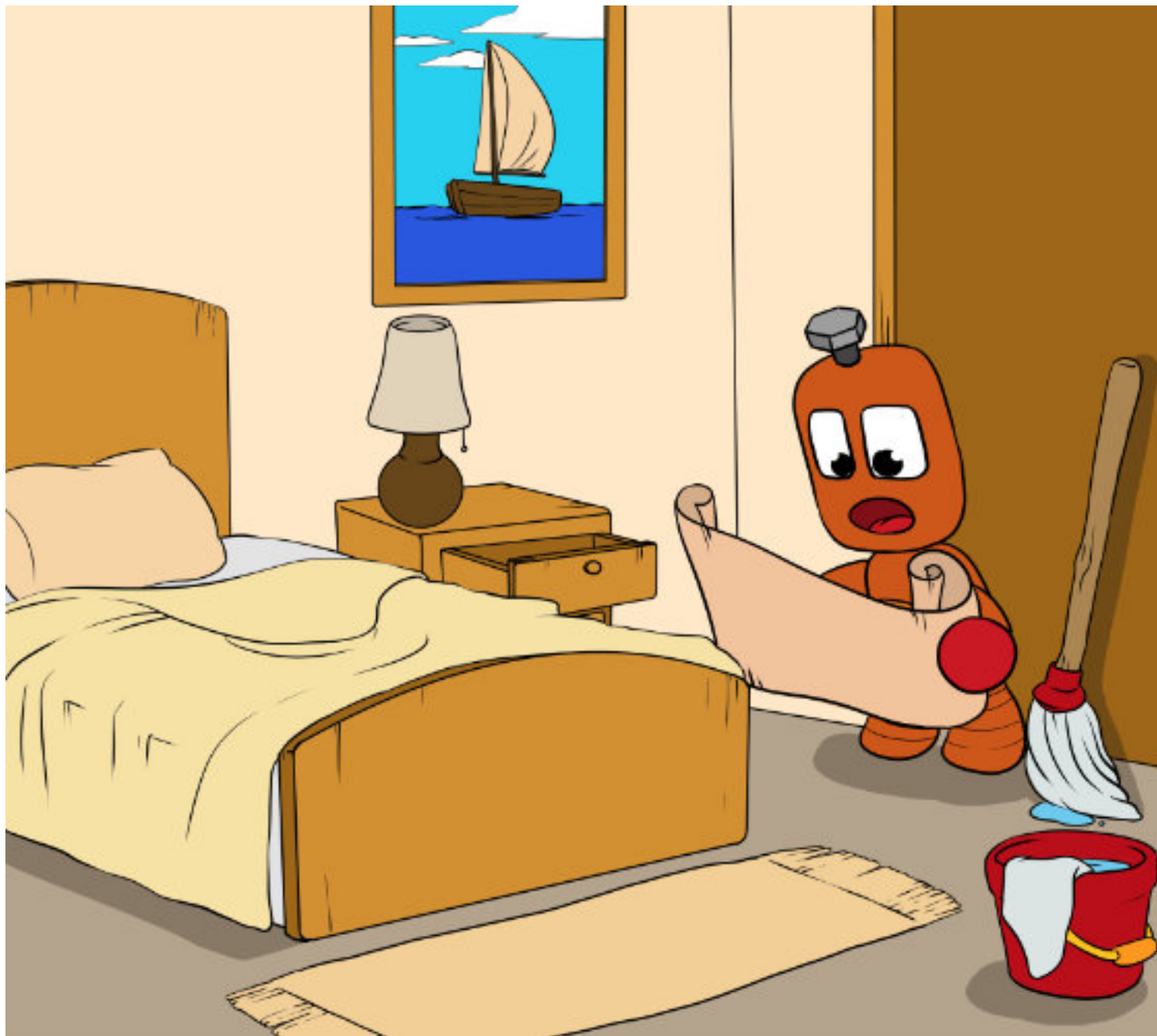
Bopbot and Bowbot worked at their mother's inn, which was frequently visited by sailors.

He had snuck into the hold to eat chips, when Bopbot overheard some sailors talking.



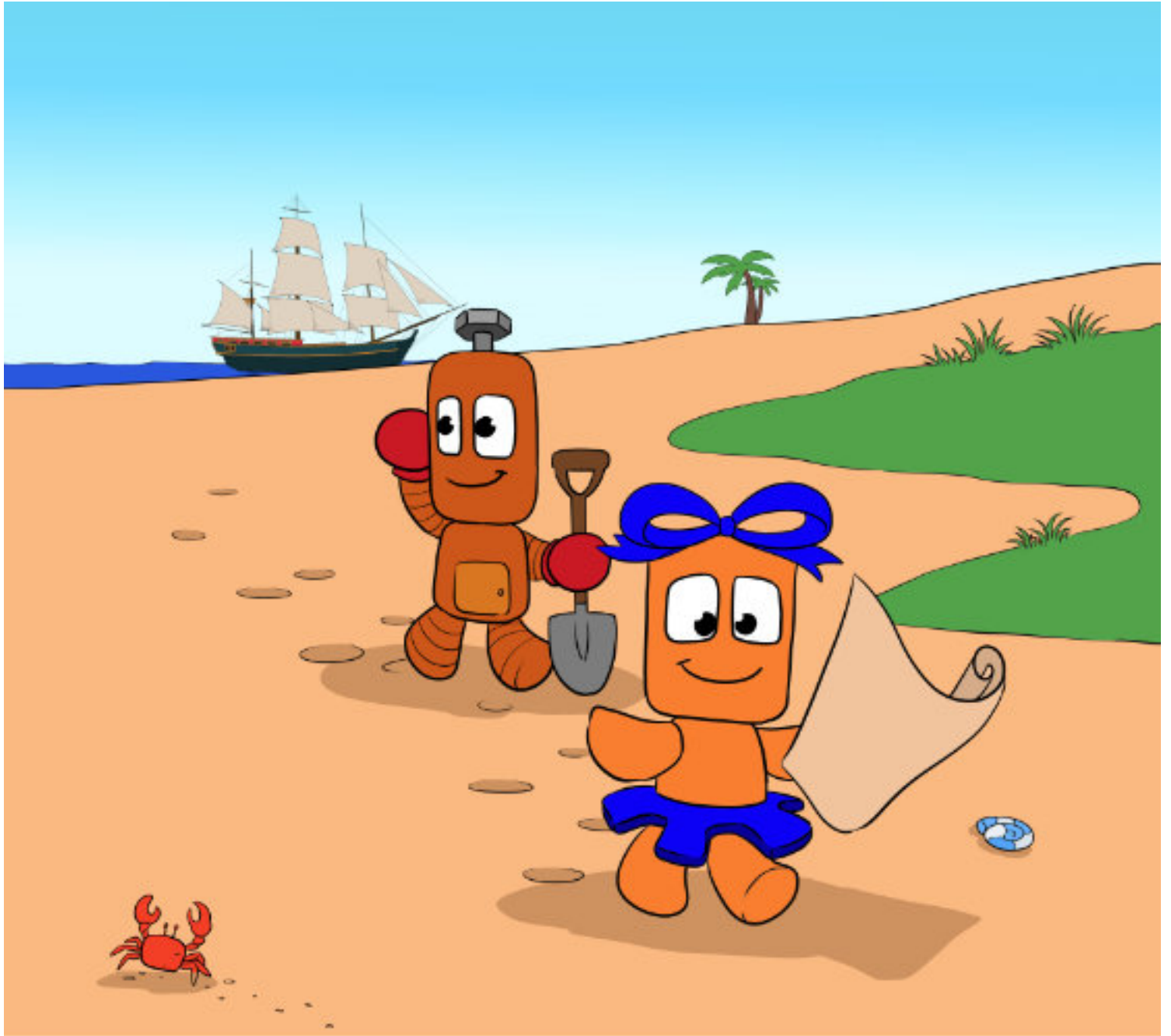
They were pirates! They were going to mutiny and take over the ship.

Bopbot and Bowbot went ashore to look for the treasure. They split up to cover more ground.



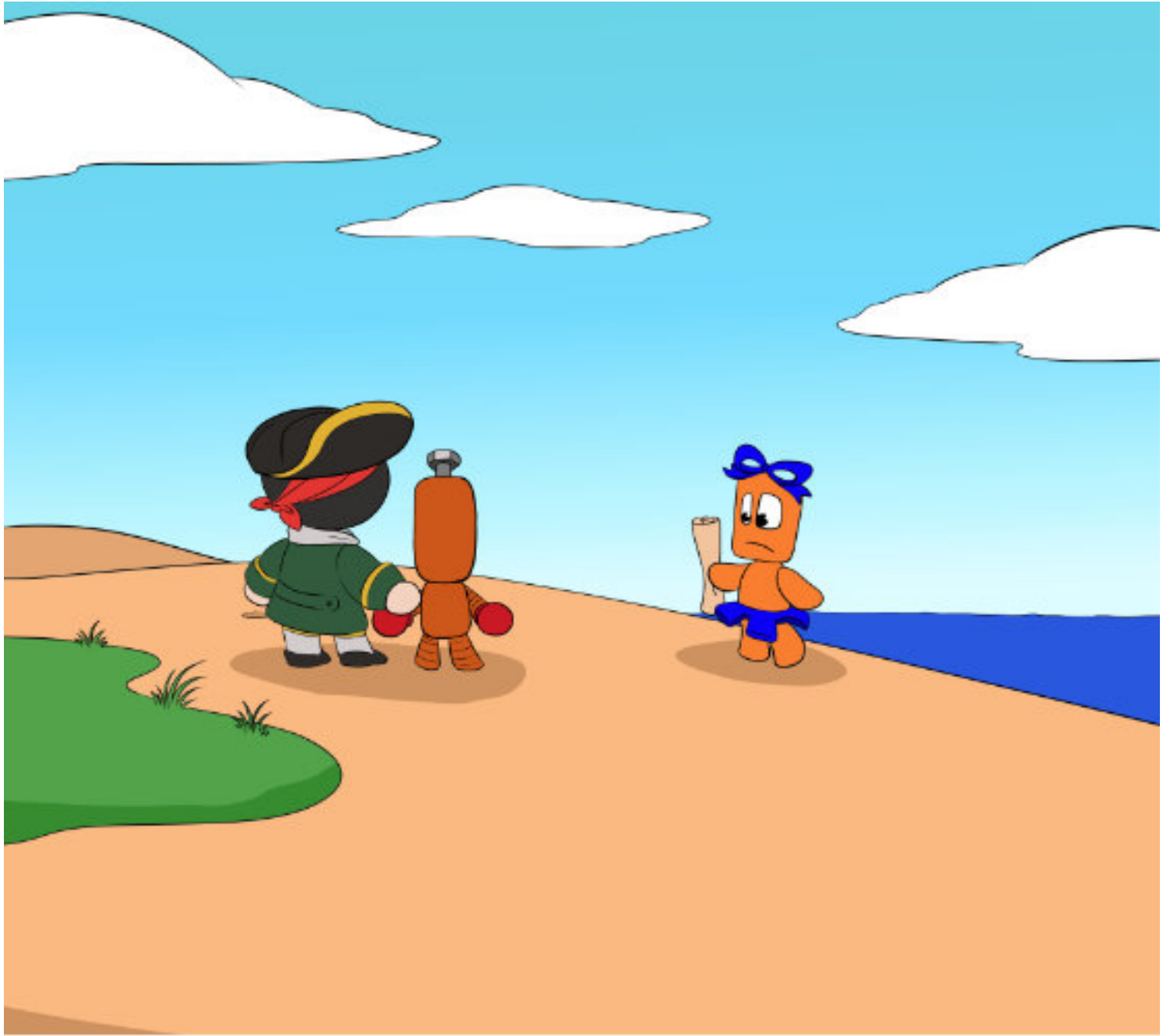
Bowbot met a marooned pirate named Ben Gunn and gave him some food.

They agreed.



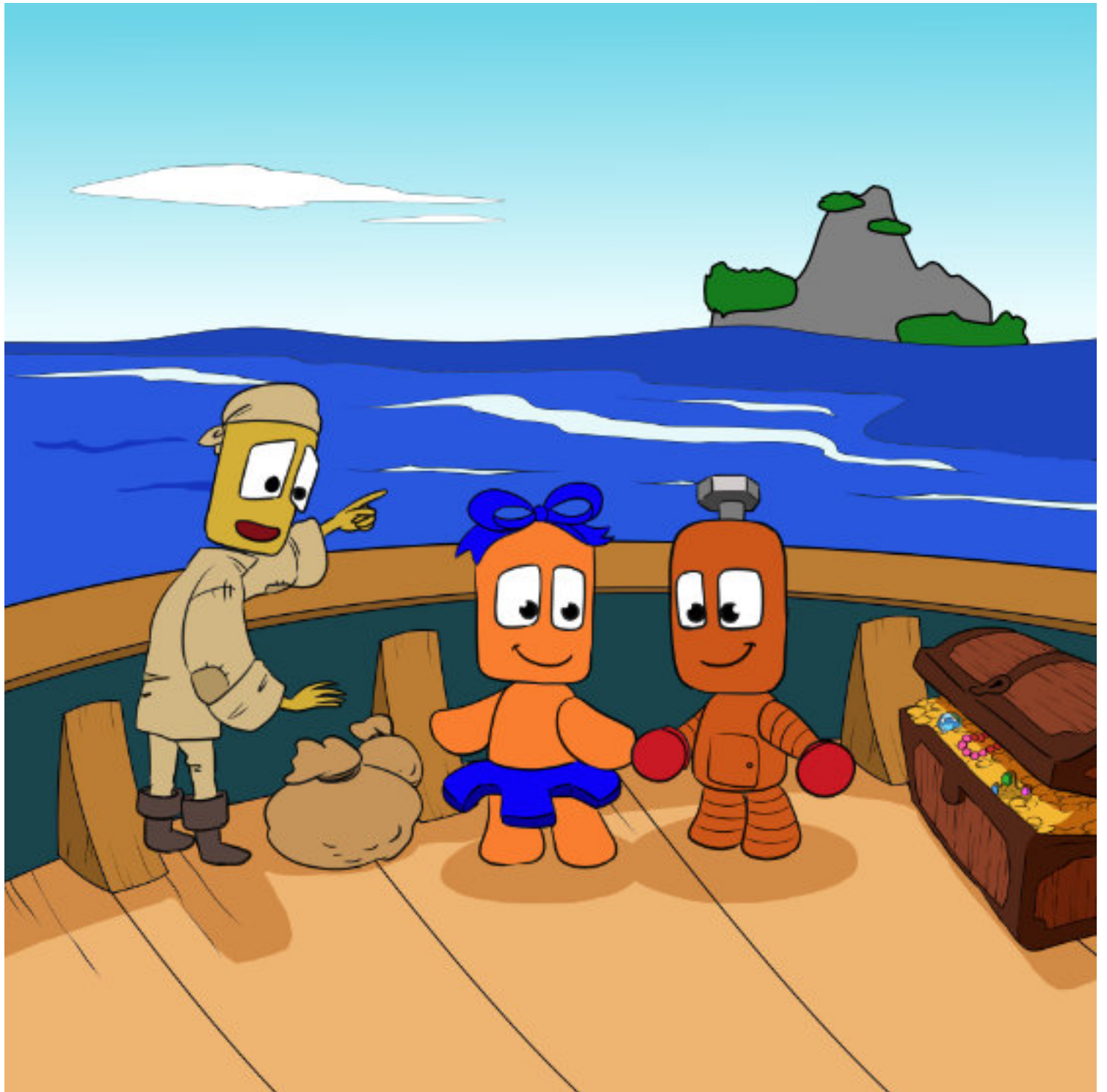
They were nearly caught again when one of the pirates followed them back to the cave.
