




Margaret Thatcher was born Margaret Roberts to a middle class family in the United Kingdom.

In government, she recognized that her most important mission was to stop Communism from spreading to the United Kingdom.




She opposed Communism by supporting free markets, free enterprise,




personal freedoms like gay rights, and a strong defense.

Some changes were unpopular at first...




...but when she was done, the people of the UK were almost twice as rich as they had been when she started.
