



Micro Tow Line (30SK-04)

Compact, fast, easy to use and priced to match. Same bag style as our award winning Sea Tec Tow Line but half the size. This waist worn tow system accommodates a pre-set (and adjustable) short or long tow. Two wide gate stainless steel keyhole fixed-eye carabiners are anchored to the outside of the pouch on either side for immediate access. Unclip one carabiner for a short tow then unclip the other for a long tow. If you need to tow two boats it is already set up. With 50' of 1/4" line, it meets Canadian Coast Guard Regulation as a buoyant heaving line.

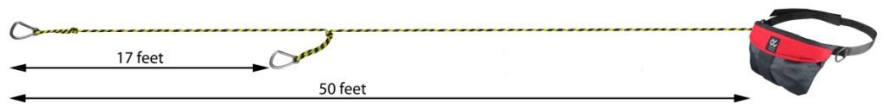


WEARING THE TOW LINE

Written instructions are no substitute for training, experience and good judgment.

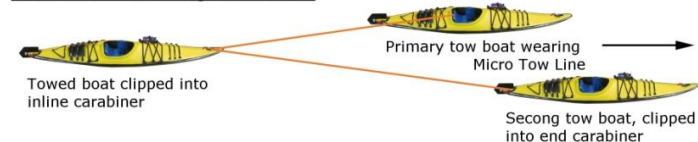
- 1) Attach the belt around your waist.
- 2) The 50' long rope has two stainless steel carabiners on it. Carabiner #1 is on the right (when the bag is on your back) at one end of the rope, and carabiner #2 is tied off with a knot along the length of the rope approximately 15' from carabiner #1. The other end of the rope is tied into a loop attached to the inside of the bag. We call this style of bag "Burrito-Style."
- 3) The **short tow section** feeds out on your right. It is clipped to a black lightweight D-Ring that is attached to the belt. When removed from the D-Ring it will pay out to carabiner #2.
- 4) The **long tow section** feeds out on your left behind carabiner #1. It is clipped to the heavier duty looking block O-Ring that is attached to the belt.
- 5) Because carabiner #2 is tied into place along the rope with a simple loop, it can be easily untied and moved.



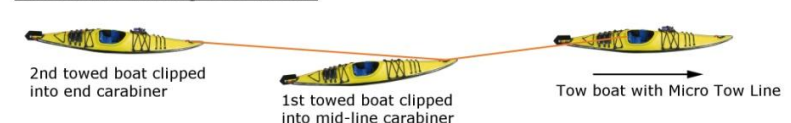
Short line & long line towing (50')

REPACKING

As the bag is “Burrito-Style,” the fastest repack method is to open the bag completely, make sure carabiner #2 (at the midpoint) is clipped to its O-Ring, and then file the long rope section in to the bag in a looping path. Repeat with the second short section.

Clean salt, sand, and grit after use with fresh water. Do not store the product in damp conditions. Inspect the product for damage both before and after use.
