HINTS & TIPS

1) If you have submitted a multi-variant assessment, each variant must be registered as an individual product on the portal.

2)A flexi-style assessment must also be registered as individual products –the exact formulation must be registered on the portal.

3)All of the information needed to complete the portal registration (except for the label) can be found in your assessment.

4)You can make amendments to an existing portal registration –if you change your formulation (and have the change assessed) you can update the existing registration.

5)If you are unsure of anything you need to include –ask your assessor, we can help you with the registration.

6)You must register ALL products to be sold or given away in the UK.

7)This portal does not apply to product to be sold or given away in the EU; a separate portal exists for these products.
