

Caladium lindenii

Caladium lindenii has an elongated heart-shaped green leaf with white to cream veining. Marvelous and magnificent, and super graphic.

Light: Part shade

Water: Dry to the touch

Environment: Plant in moist, fertile well draining soil, slightly on the acidic side; requires higher

humidity

Toxicity: All parts reported as toxic

Habit / Size: Can reach 11–23"H at maturity; Herbaceous shrub that grows from tuberous rhizomes

Of Note:

- Named after the botanist Jean Jules Linden
- Propagate by rhizome division
- Synonym: Xanthosoma lindenii

^{*}When planting in a pot without a drainage hole, help avoid over watering by estimating 25% of the container's overall volume, with appropriate drainage materials incorporated when planting.
