***Pellionia repens* "Watermelon Vine"**

Light: Pellionia prefers a space with bright indirect light. Excessive direct sun is not advisable as it is too intense and will lead to scorching. You can equate this to a scenario where you may read comfortably by natural daylight.

Water: Pellionia are moisture and humidity lovers. Water well and allow the soil to dry slightly in-between watering. Excessive drought will result in leaf-loss.

Environment: Average home conditions are typically fine, but avoid excessively dry air.

Toxicity: Reported to be non-toxic to pets

Of Note*:

- While they don't flower profusely, Pellionia will flower from time to time and when flowers are present you can watch for little clouds of pollen which they will *poof* out of their little flower clusters.

*When planting in a pot without a drainage hole, avoid over watering by estimating 25% of the container's overall volume, with appropriate drainage materials incorporated when planting.
