***Tacca* - “Bat Flower”**

There are about a dozen species of *Tacca*, most commonly. *T. chantrieri* (black / brown flower) and *T. integrifolia* (white flower).

Light: *Tacca* are tropical understory plants and should be kept out of direct sunlight. Growing indoors, however, brighter is always better.

Water: With a well-draining soil mix, provide even, damp moisture, but avoid any surplus or standing water.

Environment: Humidity is preferred.

Toxicity: There is some mixed information so it may be best to consider this mildly toxic.

Of Note:

- To better your chances of producing the fabulous flower for which this plant is nicknamed, its great to let this plant spend the warm season outdoors in a shady location.

*When planting in a pot without a drainage hole, avoid over watering by estimating 25% of the container’s overall volume, with appropriate drainage materials incorporated when planting.
