## Taking measurements .

MOST IMPORTANT THING $=$ THE WIDTH OF THE EYEWEAR

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Measure a pair of sunglasses or optical eyewear that fits you the best

## OR

In front of a mirror, place a ruler on your forehead above the eyebrow line and measure the width between the ends of your temples.

## the size chart .

| Width measured in $\mathrm{mm}^{*}$ | $<130 \mathrm{~mm}$ | $131-140 \mathrm{~mm}$ | $141-150 \mathrm{~mm}$ | $>150 \mathrm{~mm}$ |
| :--- | :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Sunglasses / size | S | S | M | L |
| Optical eyewear / size | S | M | L | L |

* a difference of 1 to 2 mm more or less can be ignored *


## CARLOTTI tips

Sunglasses are usually worn wider than optical eyewear.
It is also possible to achieve an oversized look by going up a size.
The size can also vary depending on the shape chosen: butterfly or rectangular eyewear is usually wider than round ones.


The temples can be adjusted in our boutiques or at any optician's to achieve a perfect fit on the face.
