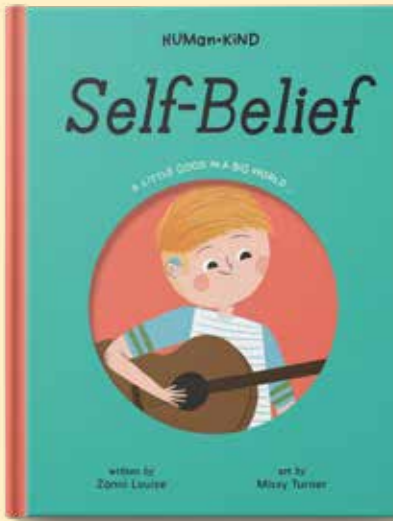

Honjok: The South Korean method of living happily with ourselves

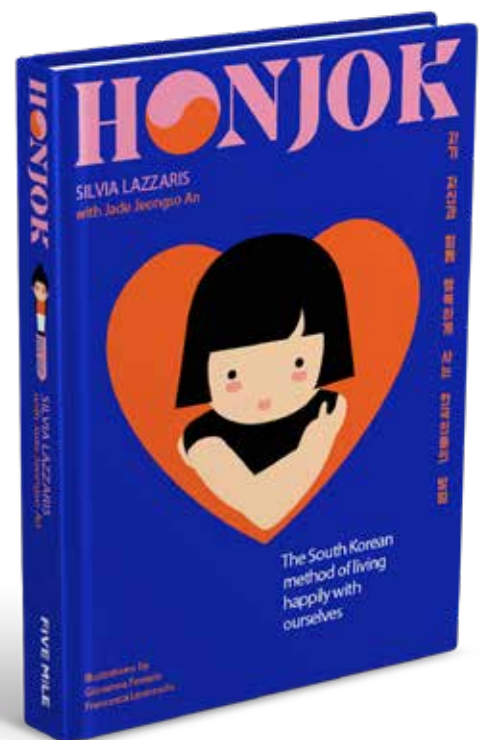


Young Koreans are embracing a movement called *Honjok*, the combination of *hon* (alone) and *jok* (tribe). A tribe of onself's, alone.

This term is used to describe people who celebrate their solitude and independence by doing things by themselves: eating, drinking, watching a film, travelling and just having fun, all by themselves.

Many other terms surround this solitary life choice. There are specific words that describe activities that are carried out alone, such as eating (*ho bap*), drinking (*honsul*), travelling (*honhaeng*), watching a film (*honyeong*) and shopping (*honsho*).

Within this book are key concepts and *honjok* solutions to make the most of spending time alone.

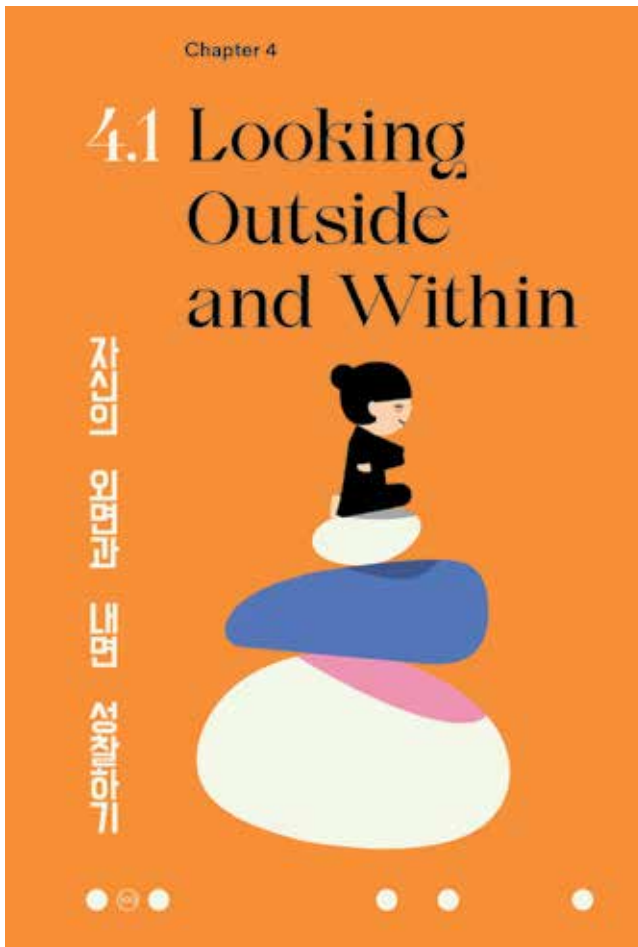


This movement contains advice that all of us can learn, and that we can interpret as a method to live more effectively with ourselves.

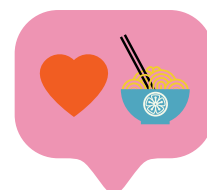

Up until a few years ago, the word honjok didn't exist. The neologism, coined in South Korea as a combination of hon (alone) and jok (tribe), has become a symbol of a South Korean movement that challenges traditional notions of family and social roles. Choosing to live and spend time alone, young South Koreans have found a way to free themselves from social pressures and give new meaning to the concept of happiness. A silent revolution and an invitation to use the time we spend alone as a powerful antidote against norms and habits with which we don't identify.

In writing this book, the authors interviewed sociologists, journalists, photographers, and young Koreans. They visited blogs and forums on which honjoks share their thoughts, joys, and anxieties. In so doing, they've written the most comprehensive illustrated book on this topic!

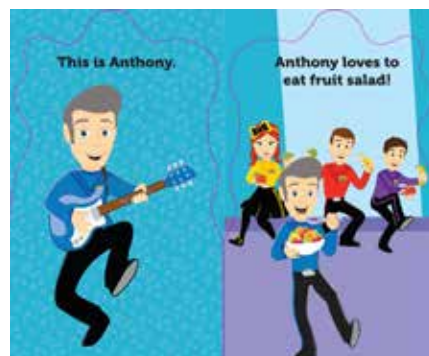

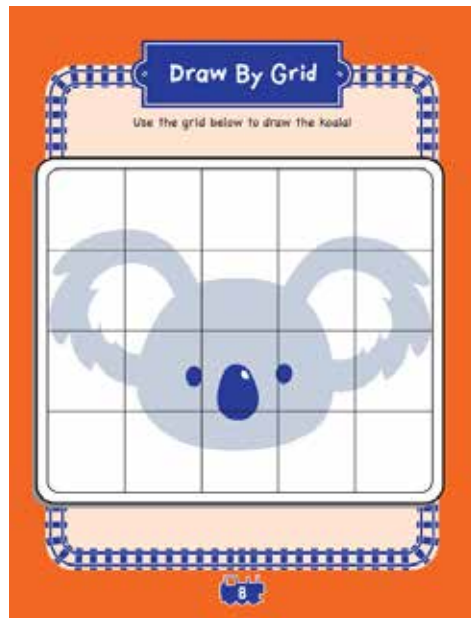
