#### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE**

#### Root Canal Preparations

Before using DiaPaste, clean and shape the canal using conventional methods.

\*Note\*: the outside diameter of the tip is approximately equivalent to a #35 file or a 28 gauge tip.

#### Temporary Intracanal Medicament

Apply gentle pressure on the syringe plunger, the paste will begin to reach the apical foraman. At this point slowly withdraw the syringe. Once the canal is filled with DiaPaste, complete the treatment by placing a temporary restoration to seal the access opening. DiaPaste is water soluble and is easy to clean and remove.

#### Deciduous Teeth

Insert the syringe tip near the apex. Gently extrude DiaPaste into the canal from apex to coronal access. Take cautions to ensure excess DiaPaste is not extruded past the apex.
