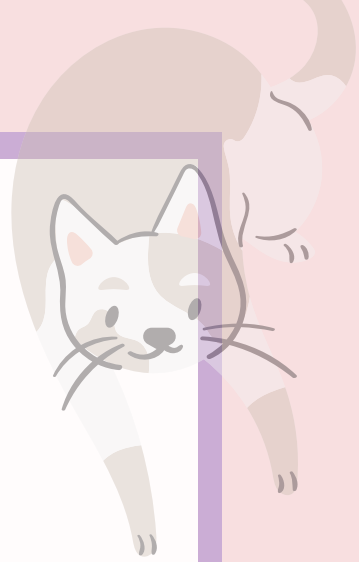




## Questions to ask yourself before buying a cat tree



### **Does your cat love to scratch?**

A cat tree with a scratching post is a must for scratchers!

### **Is your cat more active than other cats?**

Wall-mounted unit could be a great option for active cats!

### **Does your cat play a lot?**

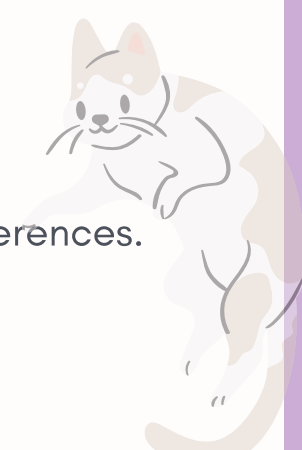
Get a cat tree design that comes with toys or multiple levels!

### **What's the size of your cat?**

Larger cats (>14 pounds): at least 60 inches tall or more & multiple spaces

### **Does your cat prefer heights?**

Choose a cat tree that works with your cat's preferences.



### **What material to get?**

- Wood: more expensive but last longer
- Cardboard: affordable, easier to assemble but not as sturdy as wood

### **Do you have enough space for the cat tree?**

If you don't, corner trees or wall-mounted units are perfect for owners with limited spaces.
