Alice Feagan's illustrations use a collage technique. Can you tell us more about the materials she used?

A

Alice is supremely talented with traditional and modern techniques. In the early versions, she hand drew each character and each scene to visually propel the story along. Then she selected a palette and textures to begin the digital work. And finally, she built layers using the text and images from classic children's stories, fables, songs, and maps. This brought to life all the thematic elements of the book. Alice uses textures from the natural world (and the literary one!) for colors, shadows, and sources of light. Every step in her process was a surprise to me, and I continue to find little gifts on every page. You will, too!
