

Safety Precautions

Important! Read all instructions carefully before use and keep it for future reference.

The HumminGuru S-DUO executes two main functions: ultrasonic cleaning and vertical down force measurement. The device is limited to serve for turntable stylus only and applicable to moving magnet and the moving coil cartridge. This page is mainly referred to safety precautions to prevent property damage and danger to the users and others. After understanding the indication and the symbols clearly, please read thoroughly and follow the instructions strictly.

Symbol Explanation



Indicating "when the product is used wrongly, it may cause severe injuries*1 and death."



Indicating "when the product is used wrongly, the user may get injured*2 or the product may cause property damage*3.

- *1: Severe injuries mean to get an electric shock, short circuit, and ignition.
- *2: Getting injured mean you get wound and electric shock.
- *3; Property damages means the damage to the accommodations, properties, the device, and turntable cartridge, etc.

WARNING: AAA BATTERY





- DO read the instructions on your device before installing batteries. Only use the size and type of battery specified in the instructions.

- DO insert the batteries properly. Follow the symbols showing the correct way to position the positive (+) and negative (-) ends of the batteries.
- DO remove all batteries from the device at the same time and replace them with new batteries of the same size and type.




- DO NOT overfill the water basin.
 - DO NOT operate the device without water inside the water basin.
 - DO NOT move and tilt the device during operation.
 - DO NOT leave the device unintended during operation.
 - DO NOT put foreign body, hot water, alcohol, and any other forms of liquid except water.
 - DO NOT put the turntable stylus roughly into the water basin or on top of the scale platform.
 - DO NOT drop the device.



- · Keep the device on level surface.
- $\bullet\,$ DO clean up the water basin with cotton swab or damp cloth after use.

Overview



Controls and Functions

On/Off Touch Control

- To power on the device, touch the "U" icon once.
- To power off the device, touch the " \circlearrowleft " icon for 3 seconds.
- ** The device will automatically turn off after 1 minute of inactivity.

Bi-Directional LCD Display

The LCD display automatically rotates 180 degree when switching the function between the ultrasonic cleaning mode and the pressure gauge mode.



Ultrasonic Cleaning Mode



Stylus Rubber Support

The 3 types of stylus rubber support provided are designed to accommodate with different types of turntable cartridges. Insert the rubber support properly onto the water basin, place the cartridge to test out the compatibility, and select the best fit^{r1}

^{*1} The stylus cantilever should not be leaned against the stylus rubber support, and the stylus tip should not be rested on the base of the water basin.

Water Basin

Must insert the rubber support properly onto the water basin, and then use the water dropper to fill up the basin with water before starting the ultrasonic cleaning mode.



 DO NOT operate the cleaning mode without water in the water basin.



Pressure Gauge Mode


The aluminium digital pressure gauge is used to determine the stylus tracking force.

Scale Platform

Rest the cartridge gently on top of the scale platform and place the stylus aligned with the black dot indicated.



- DO NOT overload the scale platform with anything ≥10 grams. Failing to do so may cause damage or deform the sensitivity of the device's sensor.
- DO NOT measure anything except the turntable cartridge.



5a Mass Weight

It is essential to check the scale at regular intervals to achieve accurate weighing results. Place the 5g mass weight on the scale and check if it is within predetermined limits (the tolerance of the 5g mass weight is $\pm 0.01g$). If not, touch (\P) to reset zero.




Keep the weight out of reach from children.



Reset Zero

Resetting to zero can only be done when the device is on the pressure gauge mode. Simply touch the pressure gauge mode (\P) once to reset zero.



The Lid

The lid is a removable cover for the device. Always put the lid on for protection.




 Pick up the device by holding the lid may result in dropping. Pick up the device from the bottom of the device.



The Drying Pad

Use the dust-proof drying pad provided and place it on the water basin to quickly absorb the water after the ultrasonic cleaning. Gently rest the stylus on the pad for water absorption if necessary. **Wet the drying pad before use.



Battery Installation/Replacement

The HumminGuru S-DUO is supplied with four 1.5V Type AAA (LR 03) batteries. For best performance, we recommend Duracell® Alkaline batteries.

- Open the battery compartment by removing the screw with the Phillips head screwdriver.
- Install/replace with the new batteries, making sure the poles are in the right direction.
- Close the compartment cover properly and tighten the screw with the Phillips head screwdriver.



Setting up the Device

Open the lid.



2. Install 4 new AAA batteries



3. Place on the turntable platter and device




4. Select the function mode to start. See next few pages for details.




Notice:

Ultrasonic Cleaning mode is on by default when the device is turned on.


1. Select one of the stylus rubber support that suits for your cartridge and place it onto the water basin.



2. Load the dropper with water and gently fill the water basin up to the level as indicated. Adjust the water level accordingly to avoid water leakage.



3. Rest the cartridge on top of the rubber support and ensure the stylus tip is submerged in the water.




Notice: The stylus cantilever should not be leaned against the stylus rubber support.

4. Touch the cleaning mode switch ([♠]) to start the cleaning for 20 seconds.



Notice: **and** will be disabled for 5 seconds after each ultrasonic cleaning cycle.

5. Use the drying pad for water absorption, lift up and reposition the tonearm on the turntable.






- Do not put foreign body, hot water, and any other forms of liquid except water.
- Place the rubber support on the top of the water basin before use. Do not allow the stylus tip resting on the base of the water basin during the cleaning cycle. Failing to do so may cause damage to the turntable stylus.



Using Pressure Gauge

Flip the device 180 degree if the user switches to the pressure gauge mode after ultrasonic cleaning.


1. Touch the (\P) to start the pressure gauge mode.




2. Place the stylus cartridge on top of the scale platform. Based on the measurement, adjust the weight of the tonearm accordingly.



3. Afterward, lift up and reposition the tonearm on the turntable.



Errors and Trouble Shooting



Maintenance

 Clean the water basin and wipe away excess water with a cotton swab or a damp cloth after use.



2. Release excess water from the dropper and the drying pad. Keep them handy after use.



3. Rinse and dry the rubber supports on a regular basis.



4. Cover the device with the lid and store in a cool, dry place, out of direct sunlight.





- Do not expose the device to water or immerse the device in water.
- Do not expose the device and accessory parts under direct sunlight.
