QUICK START GUIDE

Espressotoria® Coffee Capsule Machine Simple Setup

1. Clean water tank

- · Remove water tank from machine and rinse out with hot water.
- Dry and allow to cool, then fill tank with cold tap water to the maximum water level indicated.
- · Replace tank back onto machine. Make sure it slots into place.
- When there is insufficient water in the tank, the water tank sensor light will flash in blue and red as a reminder to refill the tank with fresh water.

2. Switching on machine

- Ensure that power switch on side of machine and wall socket are both in the 'OFF' position BEFORE plugging in machine.
- Plug electrical cord into wall. Once electrical cord is connected and plugged into wall, put power switches into the 'ON' position.
- The buttons on top of the machine will flash blue, which indicates that the machine is pre-heating.
- Once buttons stop flashing, this indicates that the machine is heated and ready for the next step.
- Without a capsule in the machine, press one of the beverage buttons and run water until a regular flow from the dispenser is established.

It may take up to 30 seconds before water is dispensed the first time the machine is used.

- If machine automatically stops before water is dispensed, simply press the button again until water starts dispensing.
- This will only need to be done when setting up the machine for the first time.

3. Making coffee

- To set up the machine correctly, lift operating lever back completely and insert capsule into the designated opening.
 The capsule will automatically fall into the right position.
- Once the capsule is correctly inserted, move operating lever completely forward to load capsule
 into the brewing position.
- Place a cup under the spout and press one of the beverage buttons ()
- The coffee extracted from your first capsule should be discarded.

4. Ejecting the capsule

- Once capsule is dispensed, lift lever to automatically eject capsule into the internal container.
- Capsule may hang slightly after extraction. If this occurs, simply lower the operating lever and open it again completely
 until capsule falls.

5. Emptying and cleaning the used capsule container

- The capsule container holds up to 10 used capsules and must be emptied and cleaned regularly.
- If the used capsule container is full and reaches maximum holding capacity, the indicator light will flash in blue and green.
- · Empty by sliding out the container and discarding the used capsules.
- Clean the used capsule container by rinsing under warm soapy tap water (do not place in the dishwasher).

Note: If machine is left idle, it will switch to energy saver mode, indicated by a green light.

To bring machine out of energy saver mode, simply press one of the buttons, which will prompt the machine to pre-heat.

Your machine is now ready to use.
