Quercetin

Naturally found in onions and strawberries, quercetin is a powerful anti-inflammatory and antioxidant compound that can stabilize mast cells and help prevent the release of histamine in the body.* Histamine is a compound known to cause hypersensitivity reactions, which can lead to allergy symptoms.

Stinging Nettles Leaf

Stinging Nettle contains an array of flavonoids which may provide an antihistamine effect. Double blind research has demonstrated its ability to reduce allergy symptoms including itchy eyes and sneezing¹.

Bromelain

A strong pineapple enzyme, bromelain supports normal mucosal tissue function and enhances the absorption of quercetin². In one double blind study, 87% of those who took bromelain reported good to excellent sinusitis relief compared with 68% of those who received the placebo³.

N-Acetyl L-Cysteine (NAC)

As powerful mucolytic, NAC helps to reduce viscosity (thickness) of mucus.* Double blind research has shown that supplementation with NAC for 60 days can increase mucociliary clearance rate by 35% compared to no improvement in the placebo group⁴.
