

# Sandcastle Matching With Magnifying Glass

## Instructions:

### Before your child joins you:

1. Print and cut out both pages of cards.
2. Find a magnifying glass.

### Recommendations:

- \* For younger children, start with just 1-2 pairs of cards. You can add more as your child masters them.
- \* Keep this activity useable longer by laminating it or covering it in Con-Tact Paper.

### Invite your child to join you:

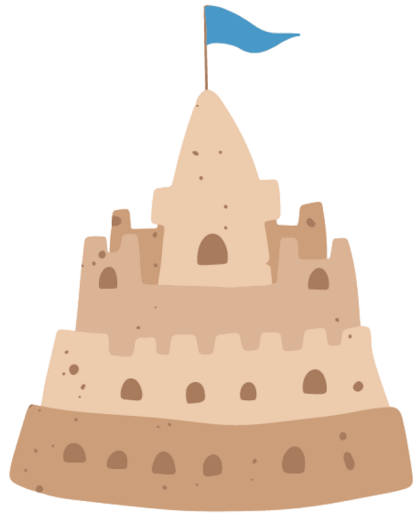
1. This activity will be new to most children so a simple presentation would be helpful. Explain that you're going to look at the small pictures of sandcastles to try and find the matching one. It can be helpful for you to find the first match.
2. You can repeat the activity as many times as your child likes.

### Extensions

1. Print two copies of the largest size images and match them.
2. Hide and seek - hide one set of cards around the room and have your child seek the larger or smaller matches.
3. Cutting and gluing work - for children interested in scissor skills and gluing work, have them cut the largest images out and glue onto another piece of paper.



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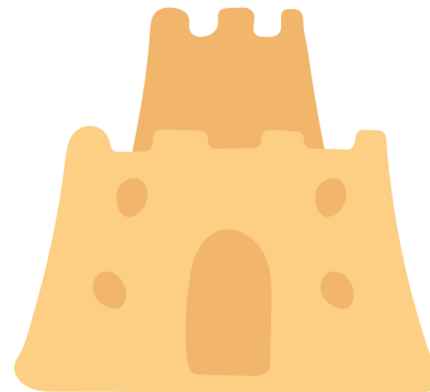
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
