

# **INSTRUCTIONS**

## HOW TO MAKE YOUR BATHTUB OR SHOWER SLIP RESISTANT

## **EQUIPMENT NEEDED** (Photo 1):

- One (1) can of SlipDoctors' Anti-Slip Spray for Fiberglass, Acrylic or Porcelain Bathtubs/Showers
- Masking Tape
- · Painter's Paper

(<u>Note</u>: for porcelain bathtubs, please repair any chips prior to application. Repair kits can be purchased at your local home-improvement store.)



### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. Clean the bathtub or shower, removing all soap, oils, hair and other contaminants.
- 2. Make sure the bathtub or shower is completely dry prior to application.
- 3. Open all windows and vents for proper ventilation.
- 4. Optional: Sand surface lightly to promote good adhesion. Remove all residue prior to application.

(**Note**: we do not recommend using black sandpaper, as it can leave behind small black dots that may be visible after using the clear spray.)



- 6. Use painter's paper to protect surrounding areas from overspray. (Photo 3)
- 7. Shake can for 2-3 minutes. Spray in a sweeping motion over area. Wipe up all overspray with a towel.
- 8. If a second coating is desired, apply 30 minutes after first application. (one coat is preferred)
- 9. Slowly remove all tape and paper shortly after application. If you pull too fast, it may remove the glaze from your porcelain bathtub.
- 10. Allow 24 hours before use to allow product to fully cure.
- 11. Enjoy your new slip-resistant bathtub or shower! (Photo 4)
