


Flip the **Bracket** and **Beam** towards the floor, ensuring the eyelets are also facing downwards. Insert one end of the beam into the bracket as shown. Use two **Table Frame Bolts** to attach. Repeat on the other end. The Large size desk contains two beams so repeat the above step twice.






TIP: Your Table Frame may arrive preassembled. If so, move to Step 2.






Using four **Table Frame Screws** per Leg, attach the **legs** to each angled opening in the Bracket.

Tip: Your legs should sprout outwards, like the diagram above








Table Top
Screws


Grab a mate and place the **Table Top** on the ground with the bottom facing upwards. Take your assembled frame and flip it onto the desk. Use the **Table Top Screws** (see circled locations below) to affix the frame in place. Large desks naturally require more screws.


TIP: Use the pre-drilled holes on the corners of the desk to center and secure your desk to the base. The center screws are optional, and can be screwed directly into the table top.




Cable

Grab your cable management tube and 3M tape, and stick underneath your table in a direction you wish to run your cables through to a nearby powerpoint.
