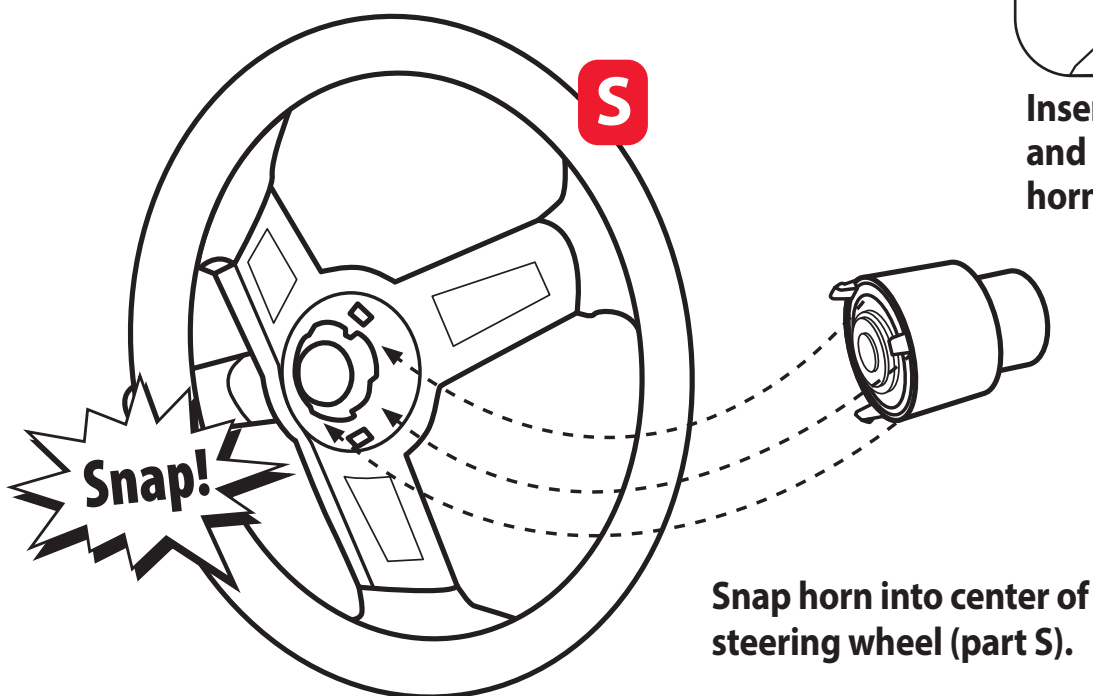
1 Start with the steering decals!



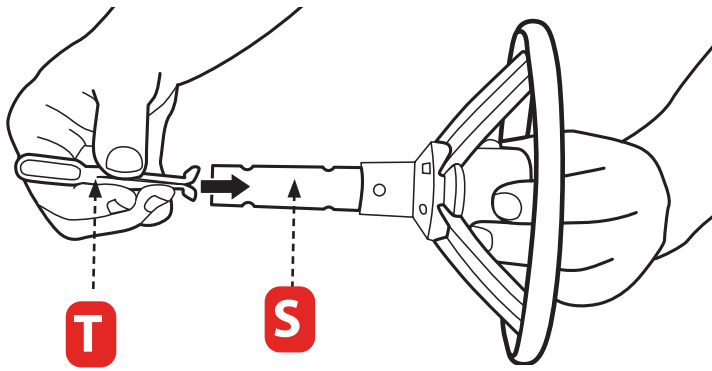
2 Let's get the horn working



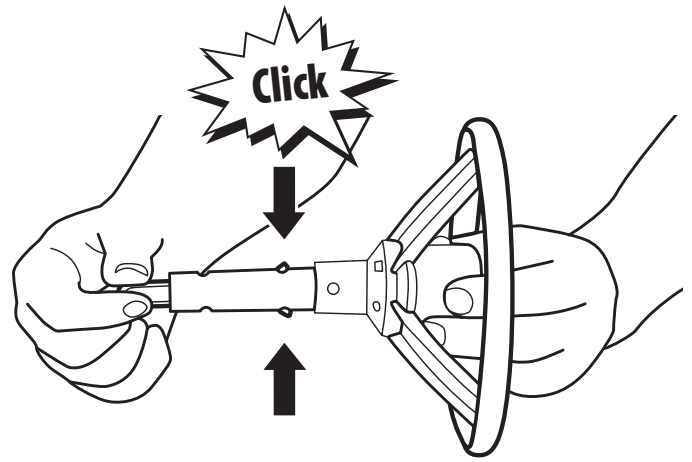
Insert horn button (part U2) and bellows (part U1) into horn collar (part U3).



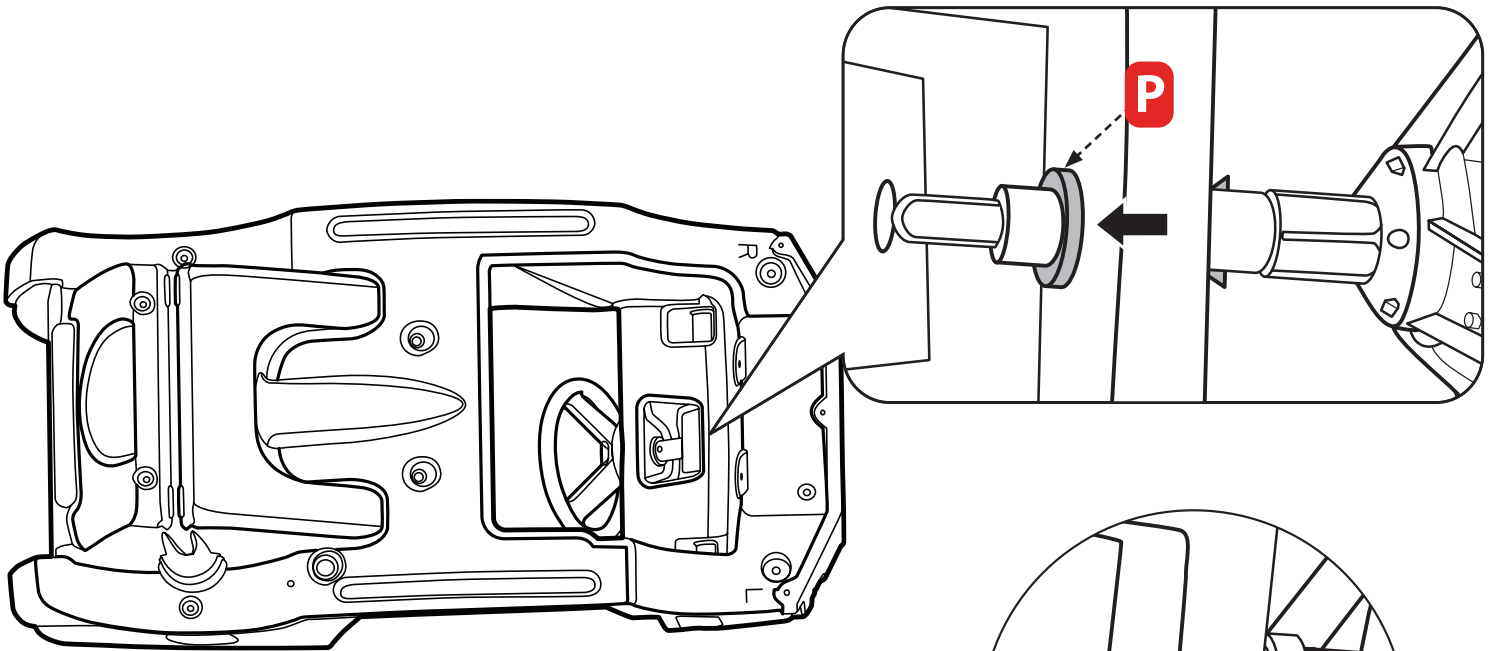
3 Steering in a CLICK!



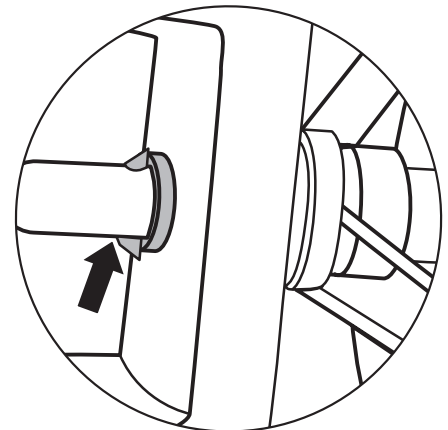
1 Squeeze steering clip (part T) into steering wheel (part S).



2 Steering clip should snap into MIDDLE hole on each side of the steering column.



3 Insert steering wheel through hole in dashboard AND through the steering O-ring (part P).



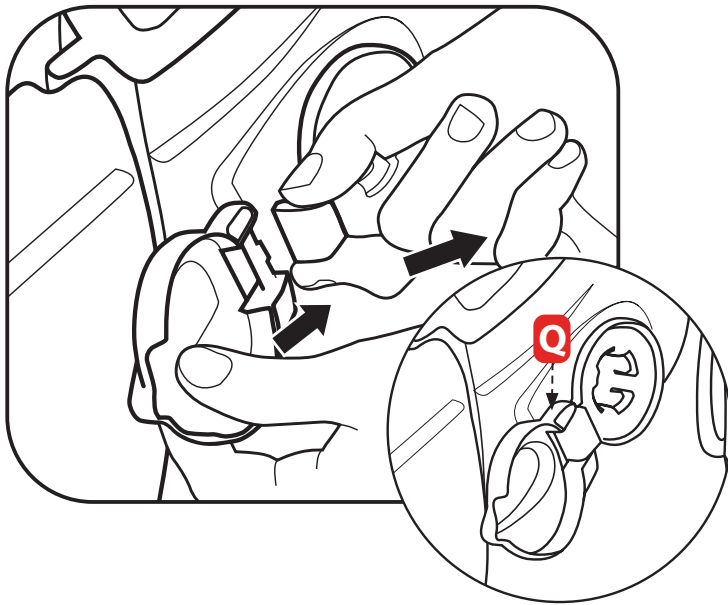
4 Make sure the steering clip snaps past the O-ring.



If your steering wheel is loose or not staying in place; check to be sure the steering clip has completely snapped past the O-ring.

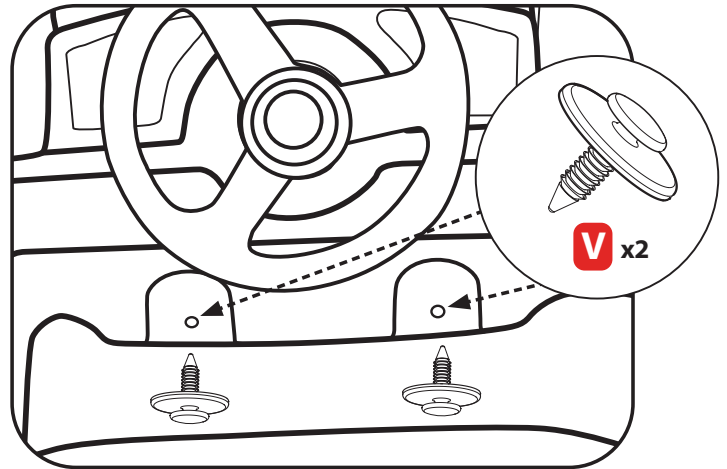
4 Cap it!

Insert gas cap (part Q).



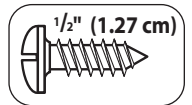
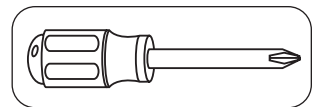
5 Floorboard needs buttons!

Insert (2) floorboard buttons (part V).

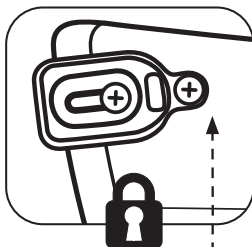


6 Ready...let's get started!

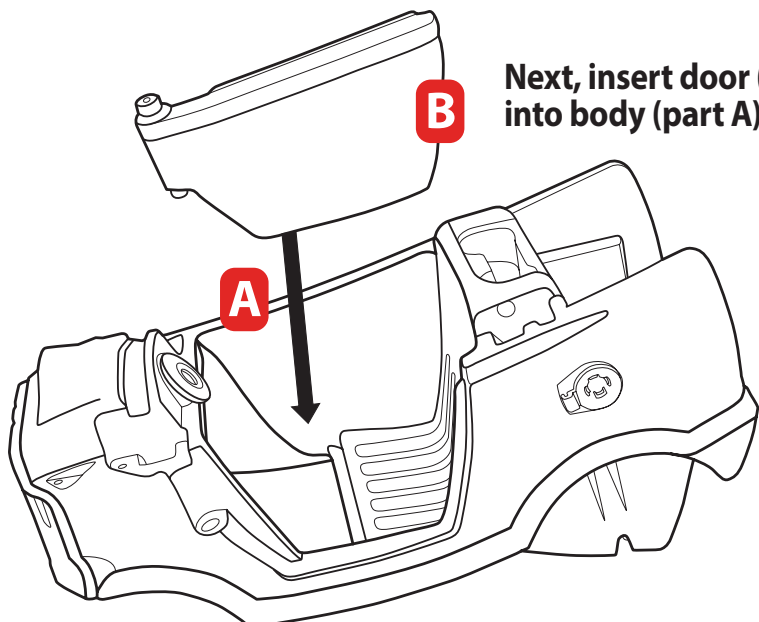
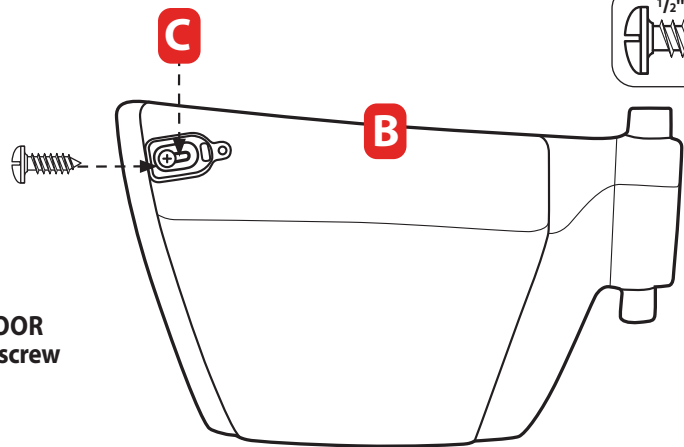
First, install door latch (part C) into door (part B)
Attach using (1) 1/2" (1.27 cm) screw.



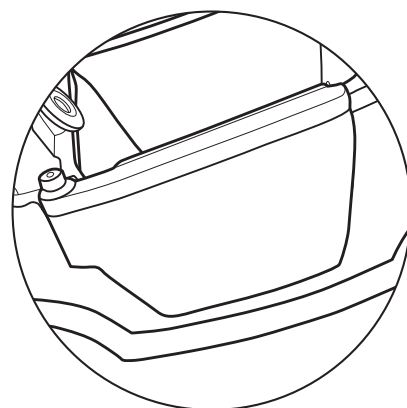
DOOR LOCKS AND

Add (1) additional 1/2" (1.27 cm) screw



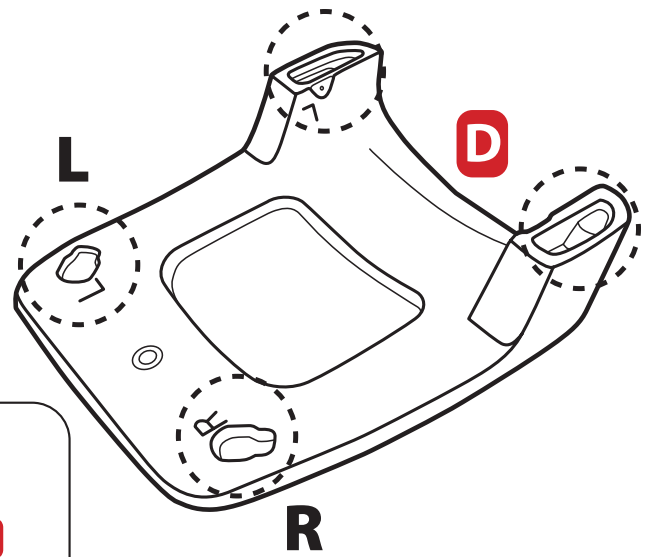

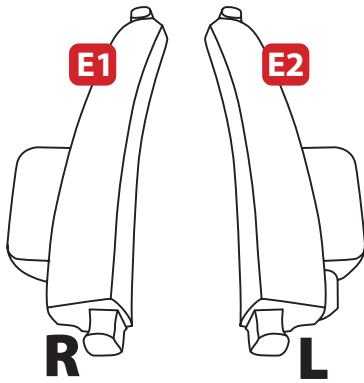
7 Roof and pillars match-up!



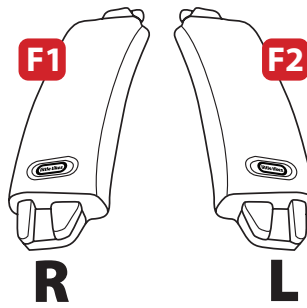
BEFORE YOU START: match rear supports marked "L & R" to the correct side of roof also marked "L & R".



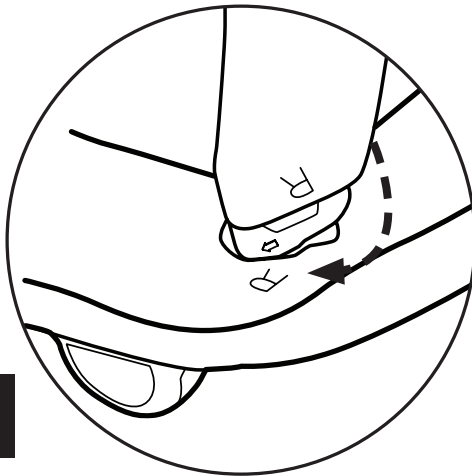
Roof Pillars - FRONT



Roof Pillars - REAR

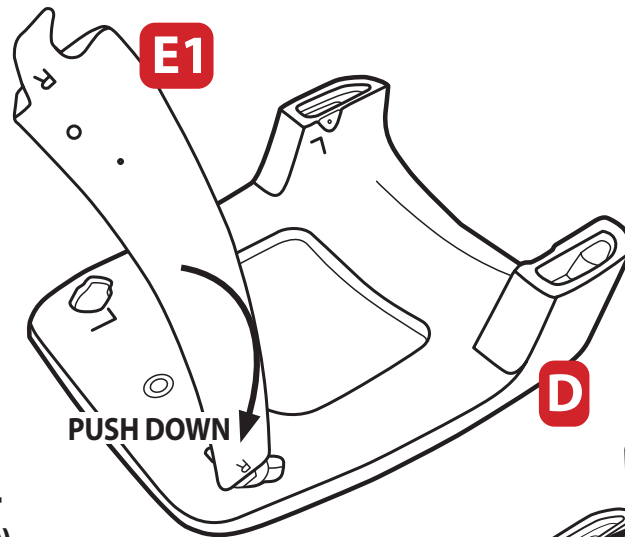


7a FRONT pillars...insert, pull back, turn!



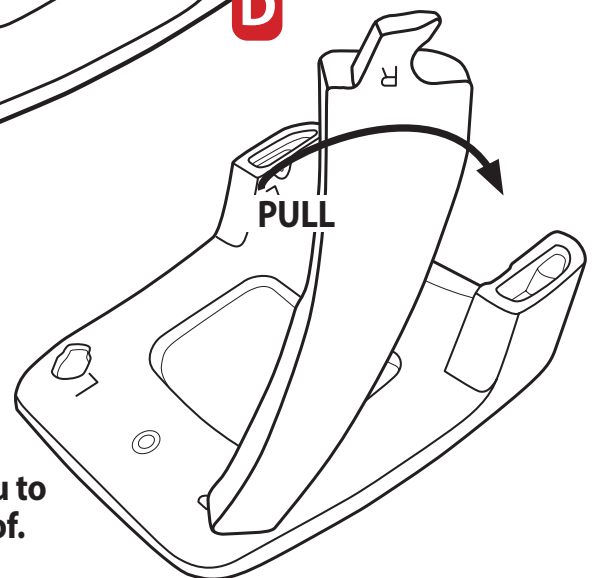

Line up the "R" on the front roof pillar (part E1) to the "R" on the roof (part D). Hook the rounded end in and push down.

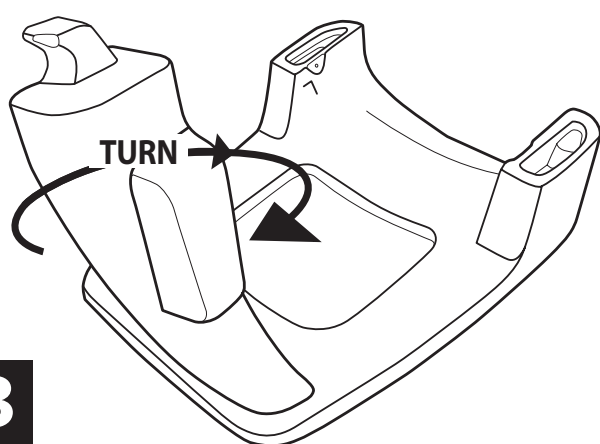

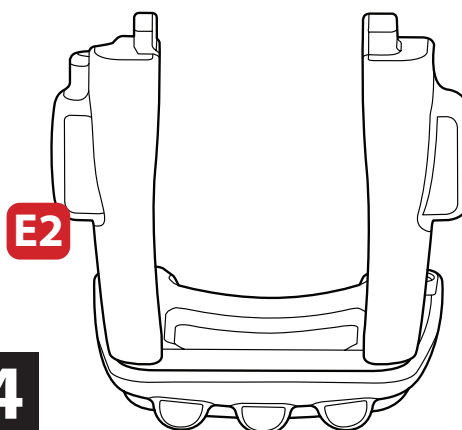
Pull the FRONT pillar toward you to fully insert the pillar into the roof.



7a FRONT pillars...insert, pull back, turn!

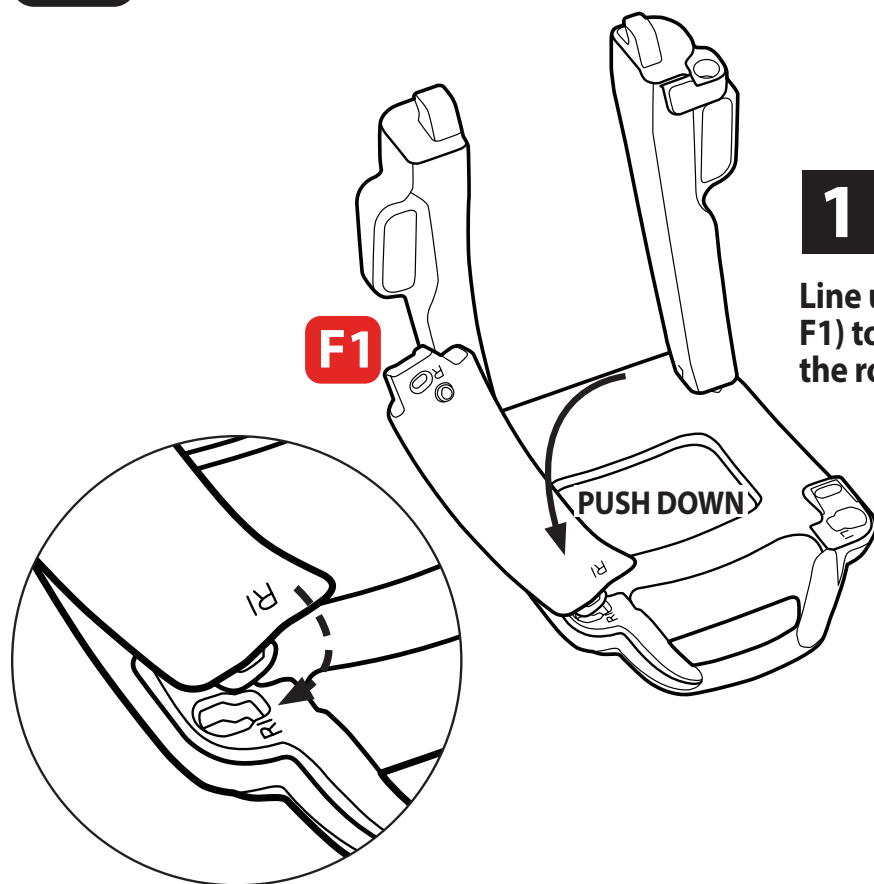

front LEFT (part E2).

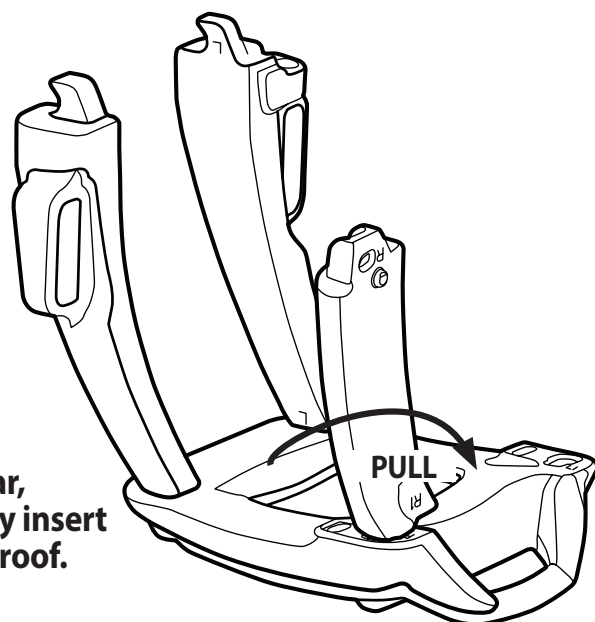
7b REAR pillars...insert, pull back, turn!



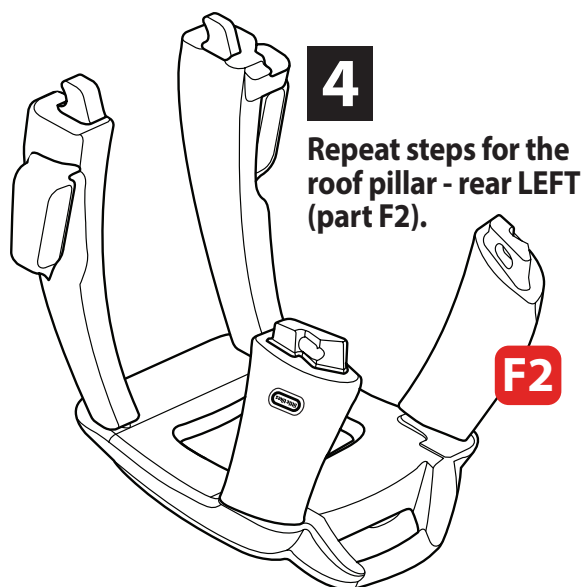

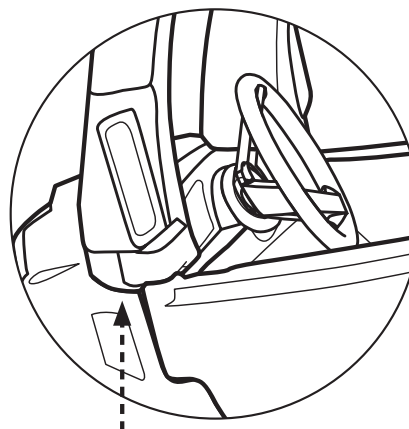
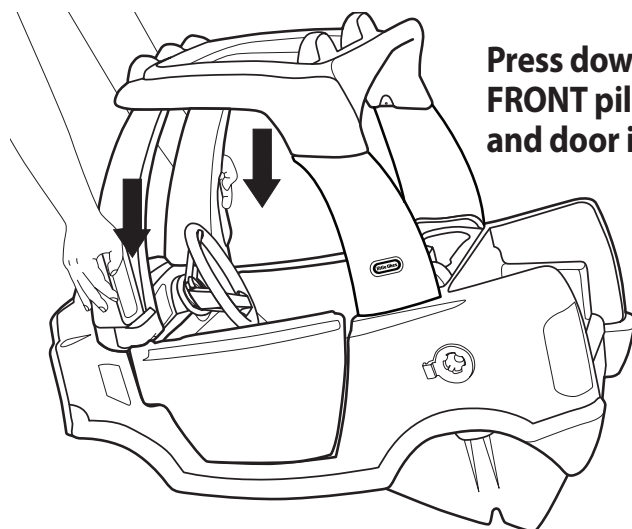
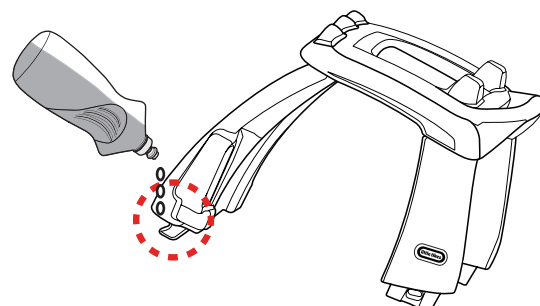


8 FRONT pillars...lock the door in place!

Insert the front roof pillars and roof on the body (part A).

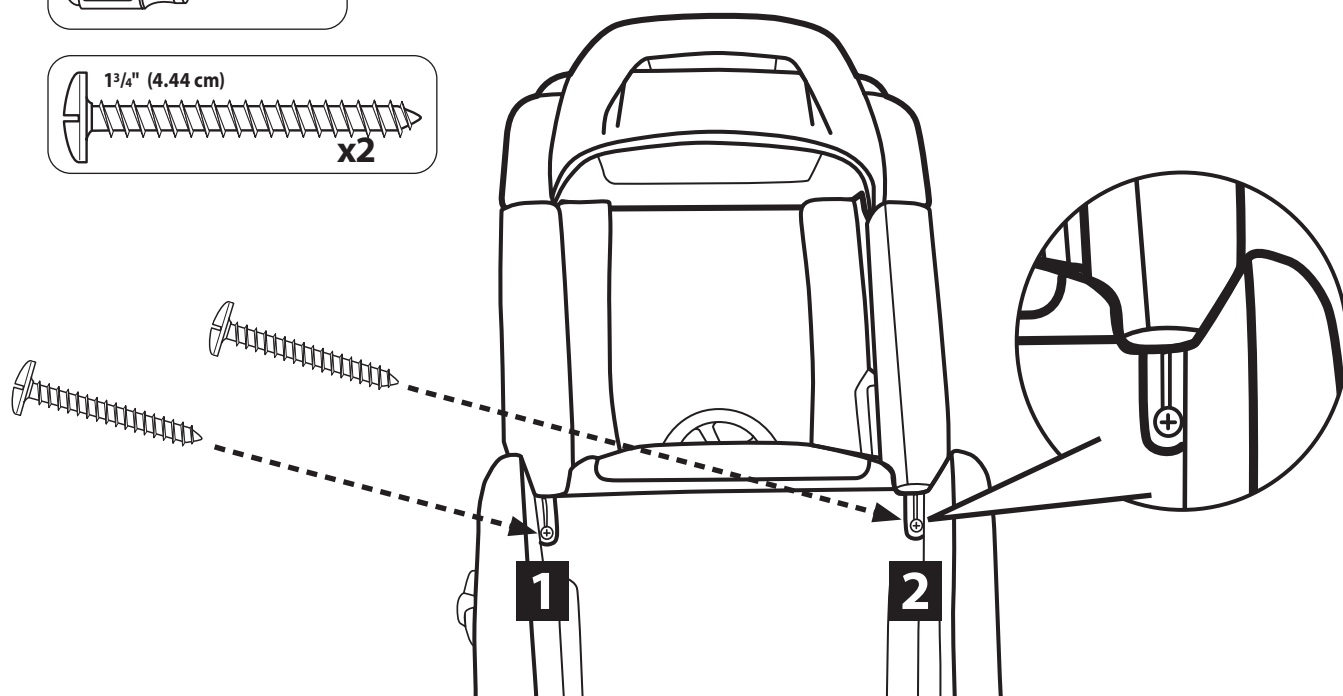
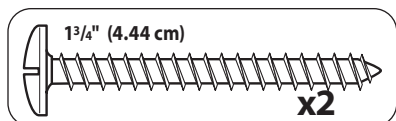
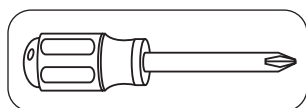


To ease the assembly, it helps to place a drop or two of liquid dish soap onto the surface area that is being assembled.

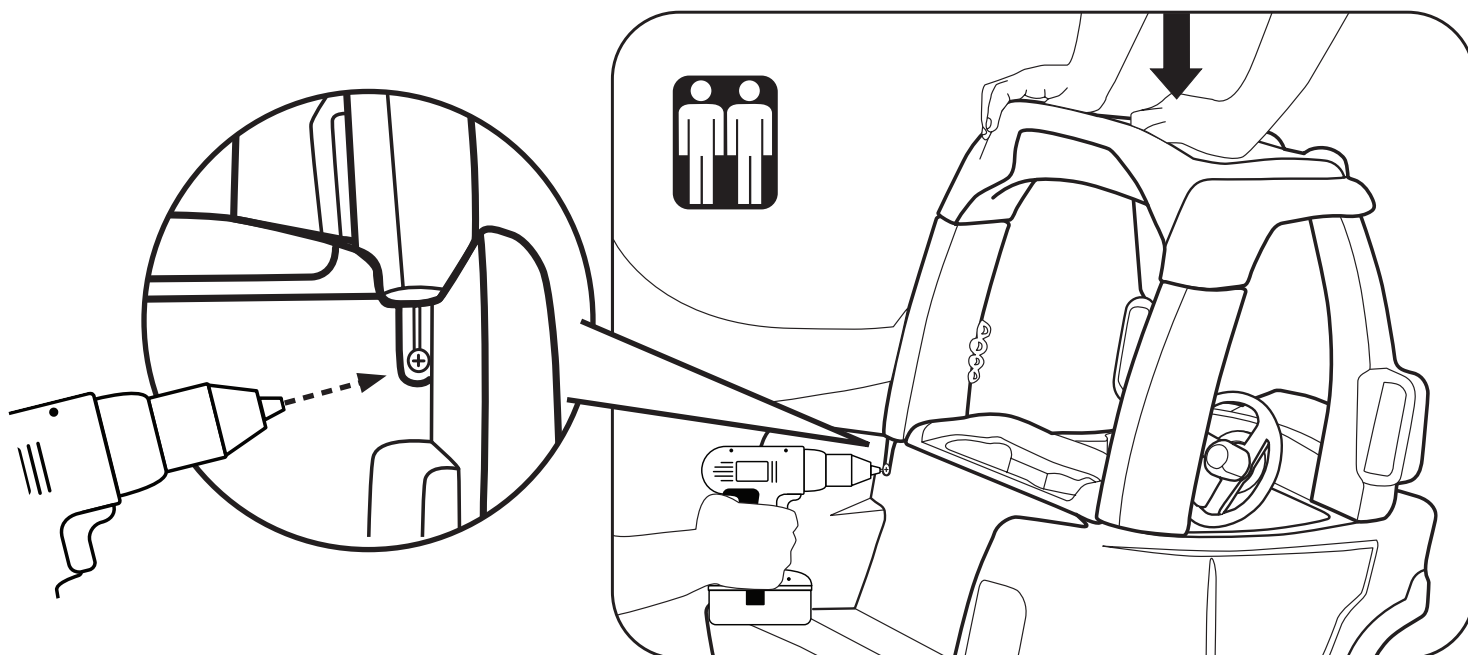


If the door is loose or falling out - check to be sure the front pillar is all the way seated into the body and over the door. There should be NO gaps.

8a Rear pillars-get attached



Person 1: Hold down roof assembly.
Person 2: Secure using (2) 1 3/4" (4.44 cm) screws.



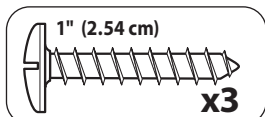
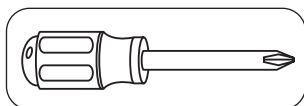
9 Grill on the front...tailgate in the back

First, turn the truck over and rest it on the roof.
Attach grill (part G) to the body (part A).

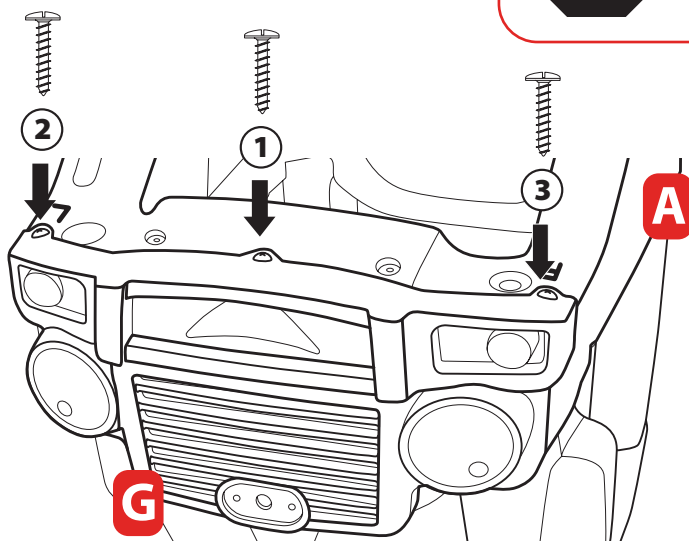


Logo plate **MUST BE**

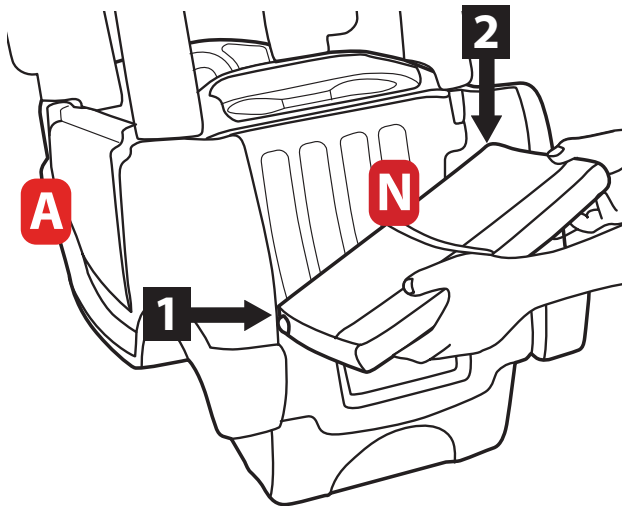
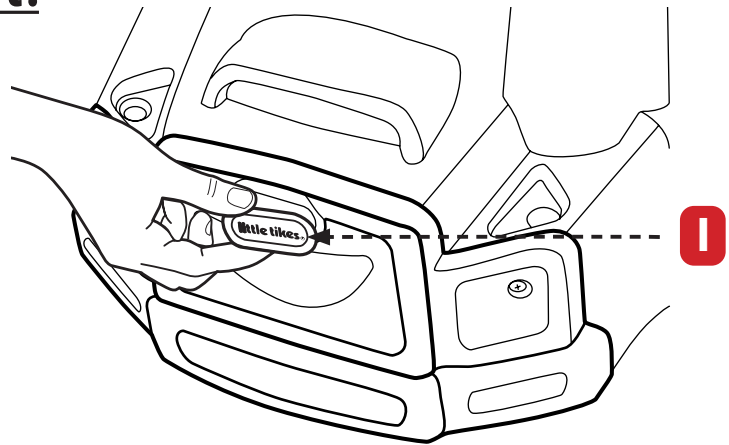
9 Grill & Tailgate...cont.

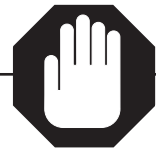
FLIP TRUCK UPRIGHT

THEN, snap Little Tikes logo (part I) into the grill.

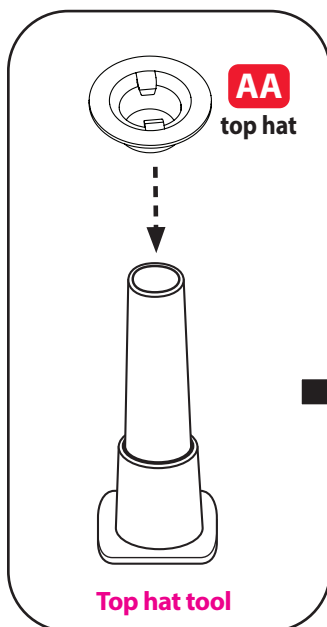


Attach one side of tailgate (part N) into body (part A). Then press in the other side.

10 REAR wheels - give it a good hit!

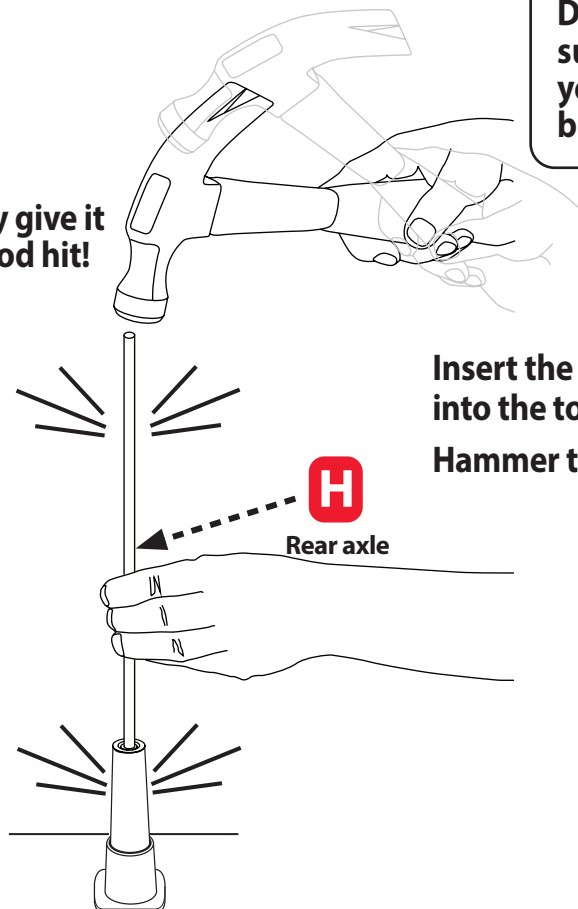


Do not hammer on surfaces or items you don't want to break, mark or dent.



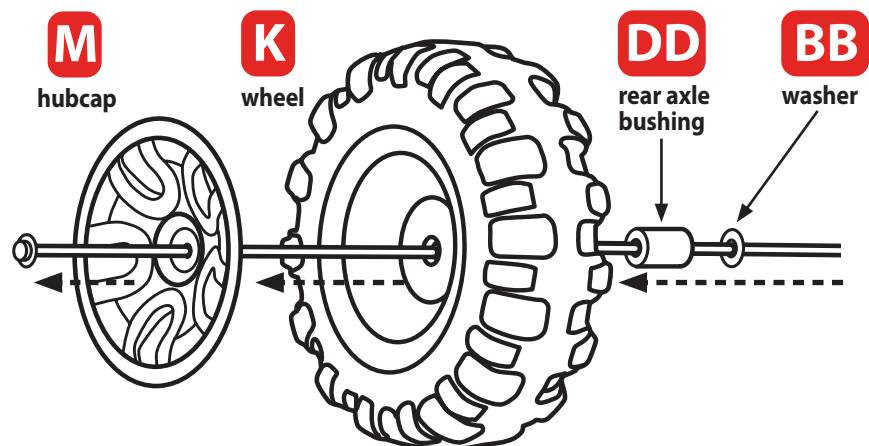
Place (1) top hat (part AA) into top hat tool.

Really give it a good hit!

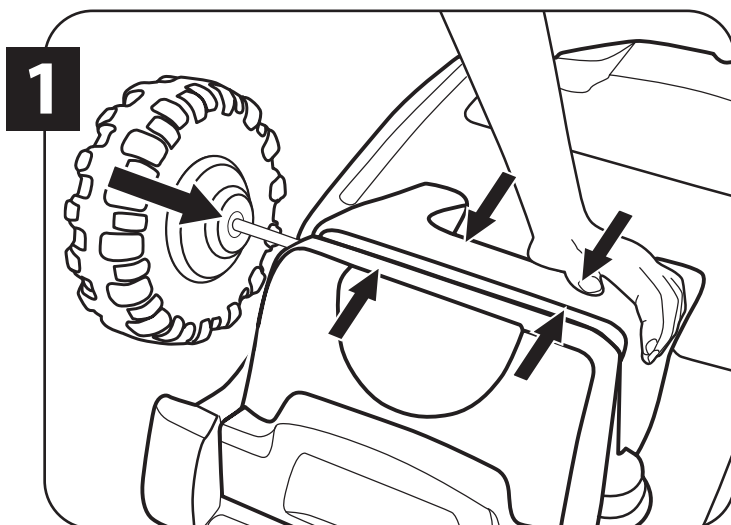


Insert the rear axle (part H) into the top hat.
Hammer the axle into the top hat.

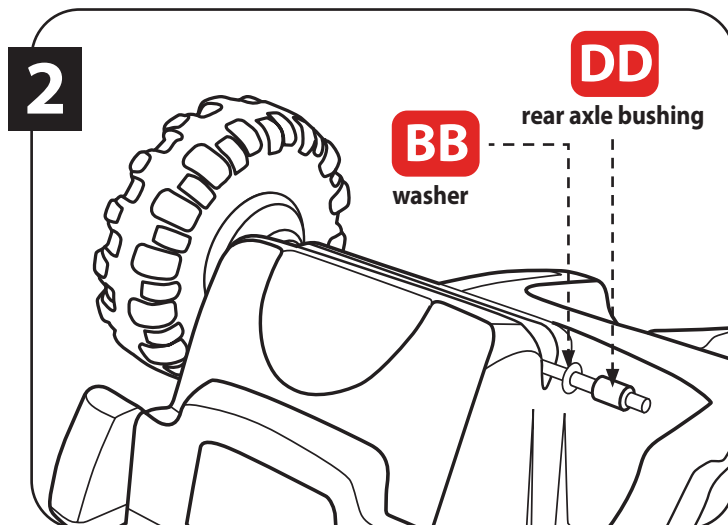
10a REAR wheels...get into the groove



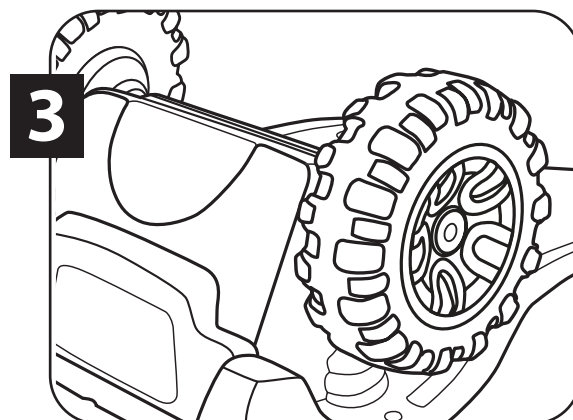
Slide onto rear axle (1) hubcap (M), (1) wheel (K), (1) rear axle bushing (DD) and (1) washer (BB).



Slide assembled axle through rear axle guides.



Slide (1) washer (BB) then (1) rear axle bushing (DD)



Slide wheel (K), then hubcap (M) onto axle.

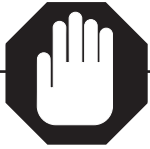

REAR wheels...last step.

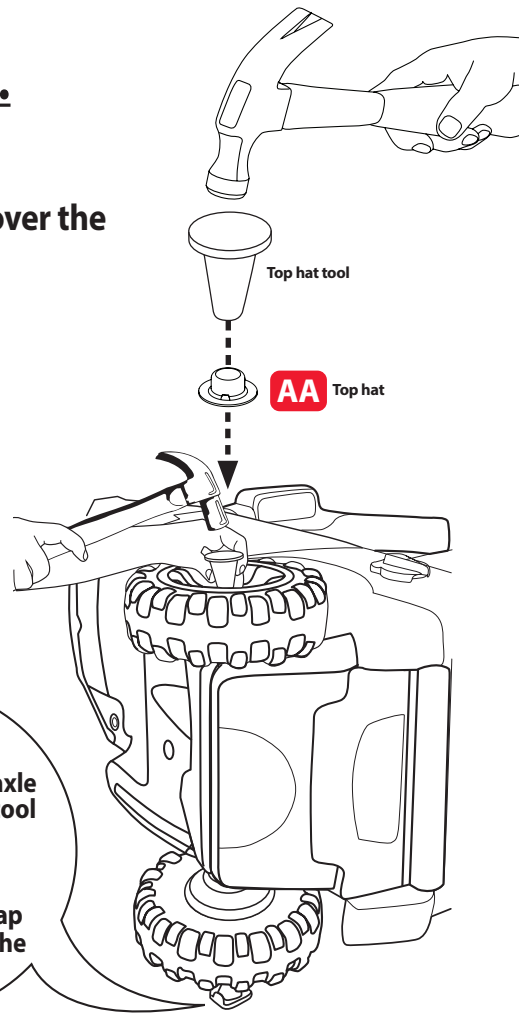
Flip the truck on its side.

Place (1) top hat (AA) and the top hat tool over the OPEN end of the axle.

Hammer the top hat onto axle.



Do not hammer on surfaces or items you don't want to break, mar or dent.



Tall axle cap tool
Use the tall axle cap tool to **SUPPORT** the bottom of axle.

FRONT wheels...check your axles



Axles are NOT IDENTICAL.

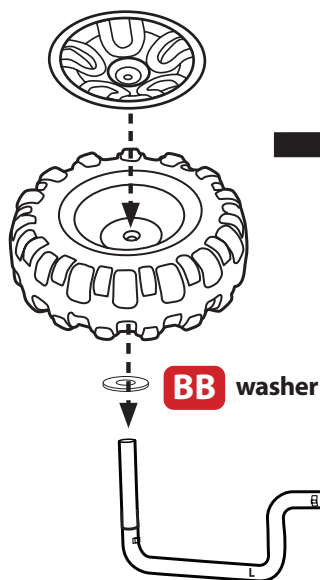

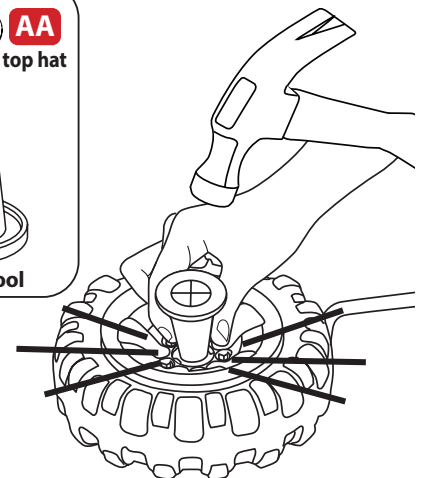
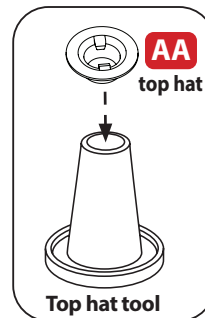

NOTE: Distance from end to the notch on the "Left" axle is less than the notch on the "Right" axle.



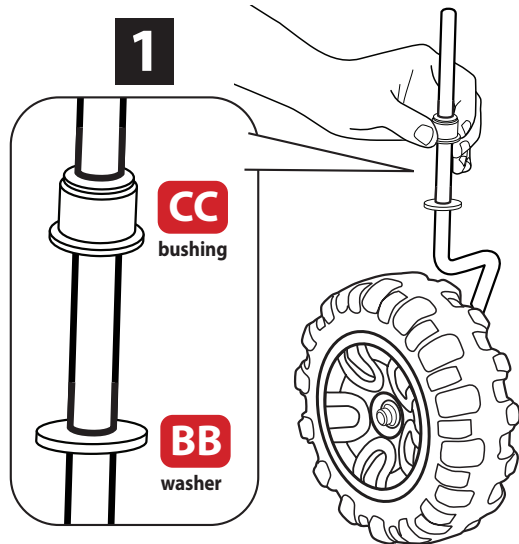
Slide onto LEFT front axle (L)
(1) washer (BB), (1) wheel and (1) hubcap.



Place top hat then top hat tool onto open end of axle. Hammer top hat onto axle.

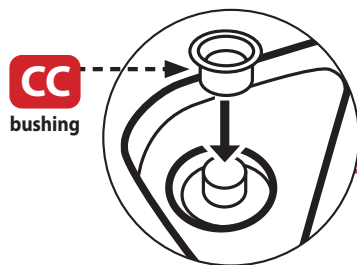
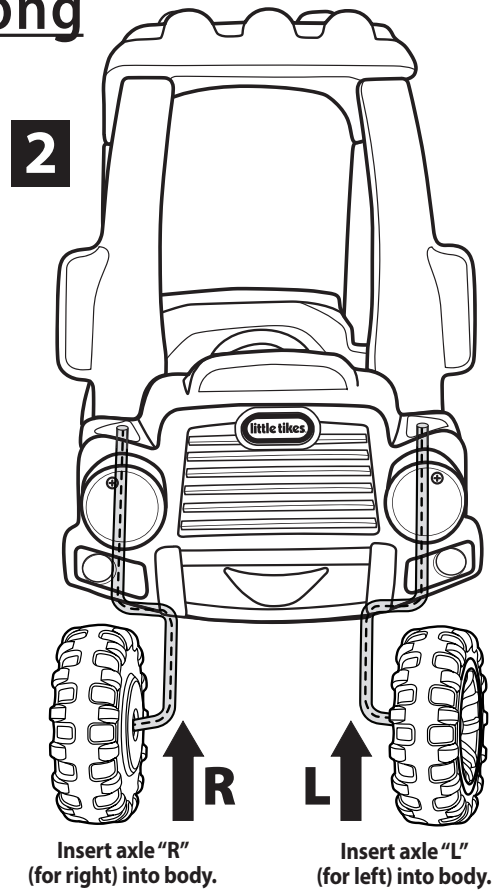
REPEAT these steps for RIGHT front axle

11a FRONT wheels...rolling along

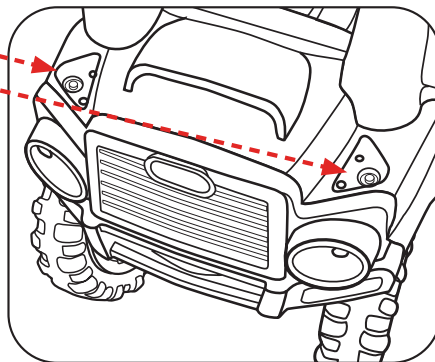


First, slide washer (BB), then bushing (CC) onto assembled right axle. REPEAT on left side.

Then, insert FRONT wheels and axles.

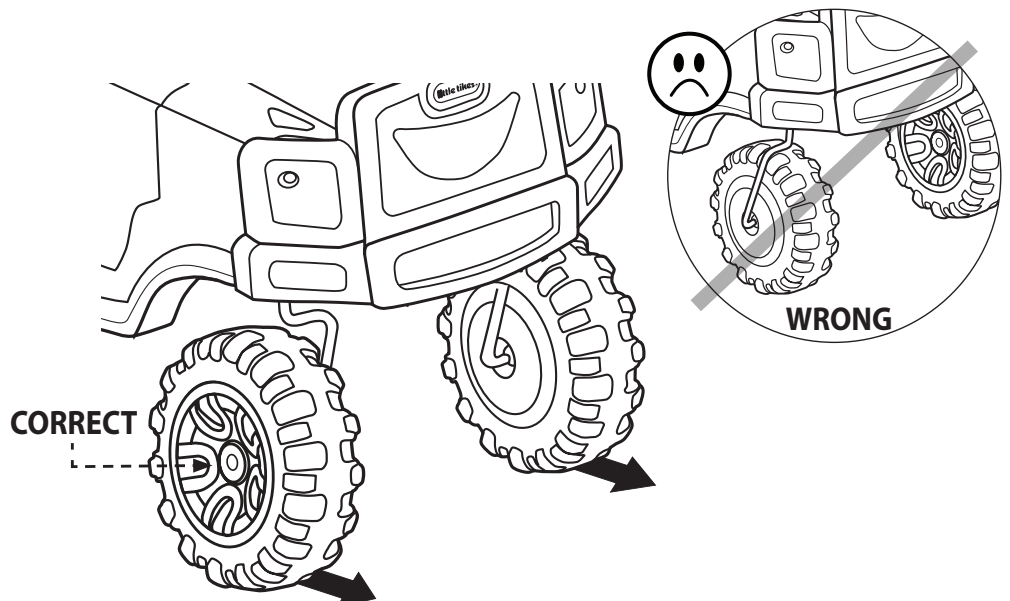


3 Insert bushing (CC) onto each axle and push in place

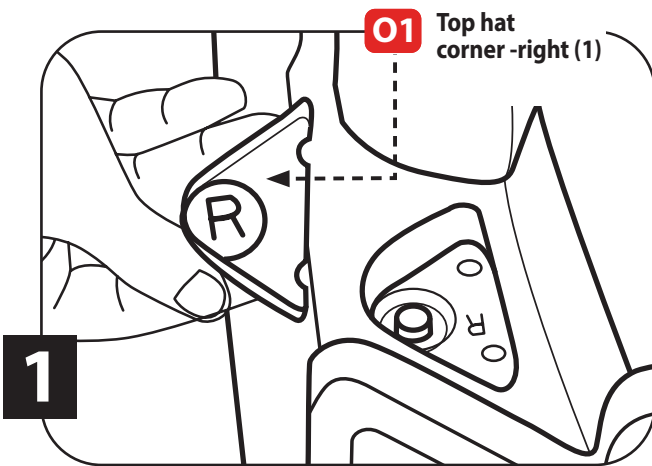
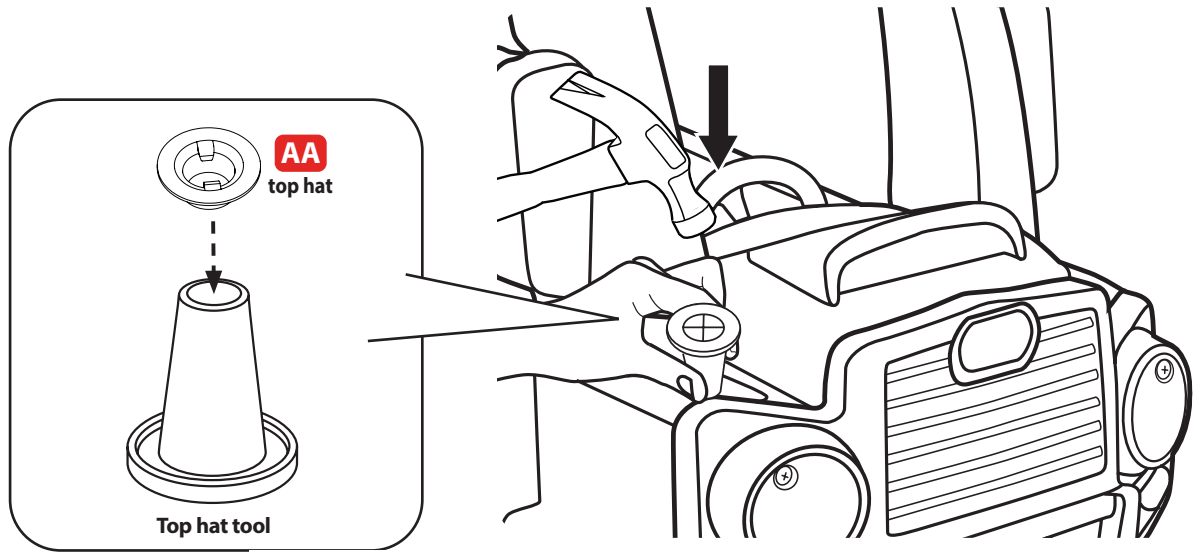
IMPORTANT! Check axle positions - roll the Cozy Truck forward - HUBCAPS SHOULD BE FACING OUTWARD.



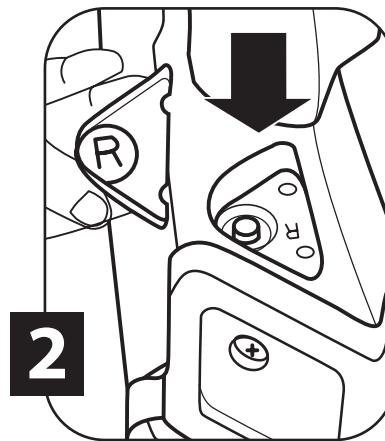

FRONT wheels...almost there

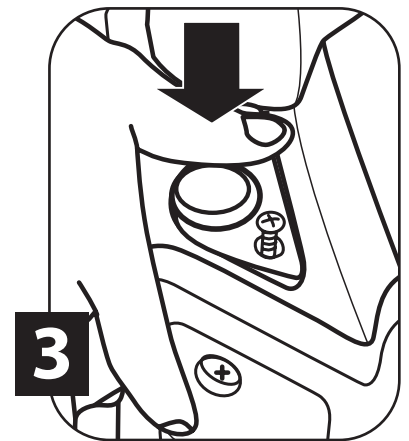
Hammer (1) top hat (AA) onto each end of exposed RIGHT and LEFT axles.



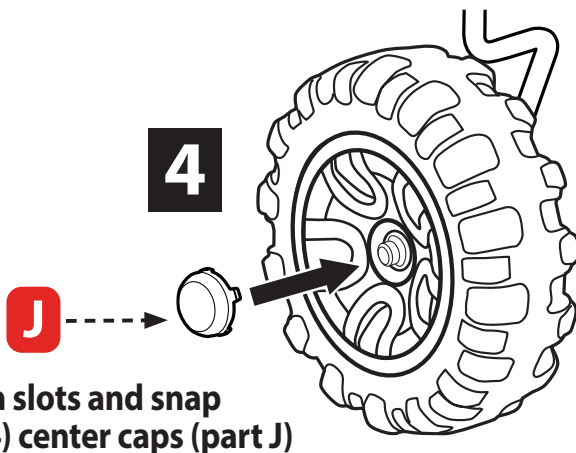
Match right "R" (part O1) top hat corners and left "L" (part O2) top hat corners to the correctly marked sides of the truck.



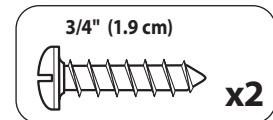
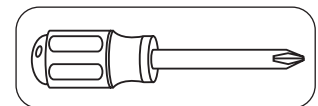
Insert and press into place.



Secure using (1) $\frac{3}{4}$ " (1.9 cm) screws.



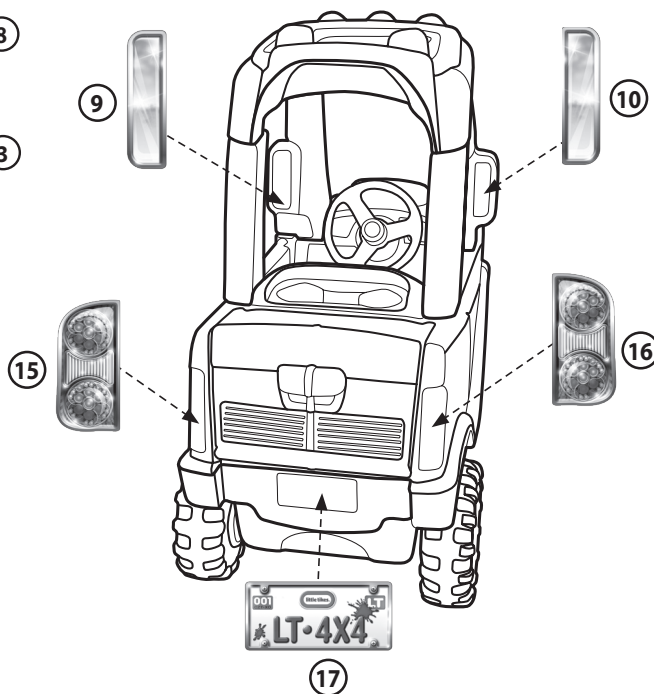
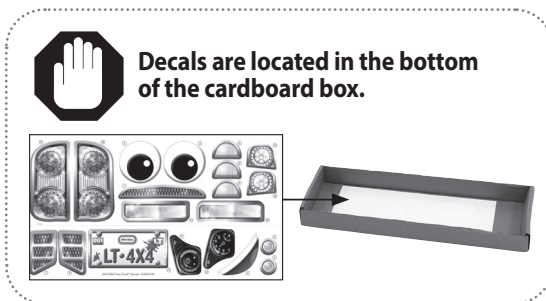
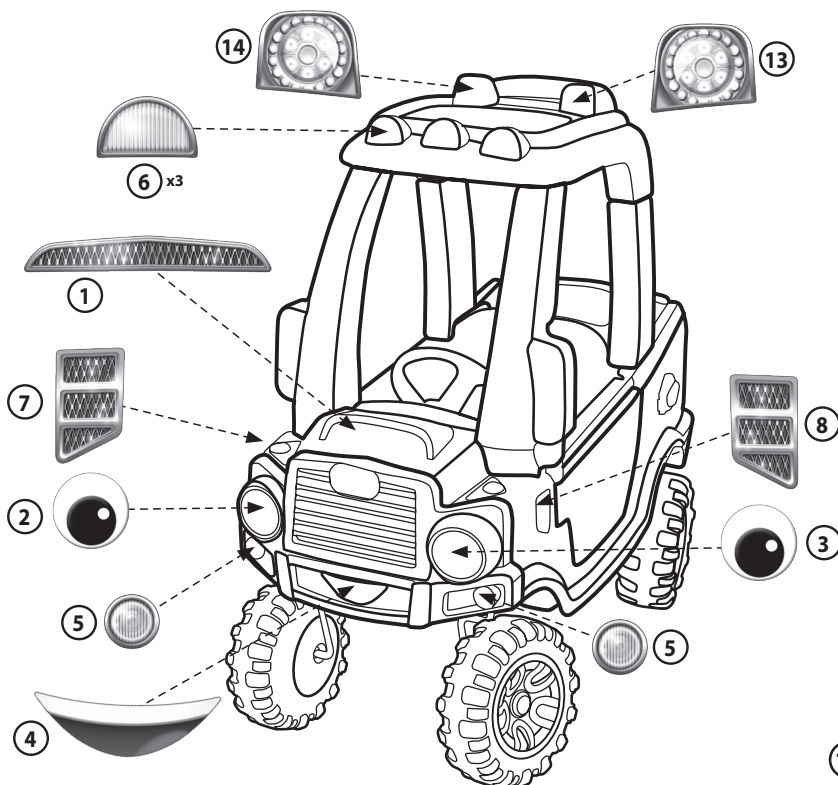
Align slots and snap on (4) center caps (part J)



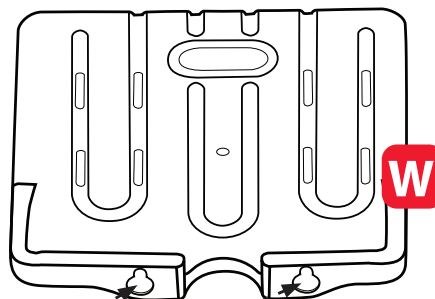
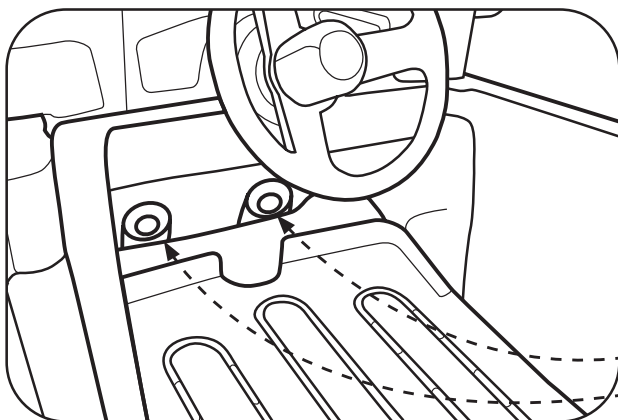
REPEAT these steps
for LEFT side

12 LAST STEP...let's finish with the decals!

Decals must be applied to a clean, dry surface. Wipe clean with a dry rag before application. Remove air from under decals by applying pressure to the decals starting from the center, and work towards edges. NOTE: If decals bubble, prick with a pin to remove the air.



For parent controlled push rides, install the floorboard.



Line up openings in floorboard (part W) to floorboard buttons.

Once buttons are inserted into floorboard, push down to secure in place.
