

BATTERY REPLACEMENT

The batteries included in the unit are for in-store demonstration. Before playing, an adult must install fresh alkaline batteries (not included) in the unit. Here's how:

- 1. Turn the music player over and locate the battery door (Fig. 1).
- 2. Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included), remove the screw and battery compartment cover.
- 3. Install two (2) 1.5V AAA (LR03) alkaline batteries (not included) making sure the (+) and (-) ends face the proper direction as indicated on the battery door and the inside of the battery compartment.
- 4. Replace the compartment cover and securely tighten the screw to ensure the compartment is closed.

• This toy produces flashes that may be a trigger for individuals with photosensitive epilepsy.




- Move the switch from the TRY ME [X] position (Fig. 2) to the Low Volume [ζ) or High Volume [()) positions.






D. PRETEND PLAY:
