Tour of Facility	<p>Take a tour of our 5,000 square foot warehouse and studio showing how books are processed and sorted when they arrive. Explore the different paths a book takes dependent on value, condition and aesthetic.</p> <p>Get a snapshot of how a small business runs from product generation to shipping.</p>	
Book Binding Lesson	<p>We will explain different aspects of a book and the many ways a book can be created.</p> <p>Participants will be able to take apart an old book and identify some of the aspects we discussed.</p> <p>We will also discuss ways a book can still be used if damaged rather than throwing them away.</p>	
Create a Book	<p>Participants will learn how to create a book by making signatures and learning to sew the binding to a cover.</p> <p>They will get to choose from a wide variety of papers and covers to create a book that is meaningful to them. Options include but are not limited to writing journal, art journal, scrapbook, travel journal, bible journal, altered book and more.</p>	
Get Creative	<p>Once the book is complete, enjoy some time to decorate the cover using various materials and craft supplies.</p> <p>Options include but are not limited to embossing, drawing, wax seals, painting, stamping and more.</p>
