



Installation for New Post Frame Pole Barn Roof Open Interior (R-Value 9.0 or 6.4)

Please read and follow all of the steps below to ensure proper installation.

Products Suggested:

• Reflex-AirTM Double Reflective or White / Reflective Bubble radiant barrier insulation

Materials Needed:

- Tape Measure
- Utility knife
- Scissors
- Staple gun and 5/16" staples
- Foil or White tape

Instructions for Bottom of Purlins (R-Value 9.0):

- 1. After trusses are set, run two purlins to make sure the trusses are not pulled out of line.
- 2. Attach **Radiant GUARD**™ bubble insulation to the first truss with at least 5/16" staples. Temporarily nail a 2" x 4" block to the truss to prevent it from pulling away.
- 3. Roll out the bubble insulation across the trusses, pull it tight and staple.
- 4. Butt seams or overlap bubble insulation and tape the seams to gain an air-tight seal (gaps will cause air infiltration, which may cause condensation).
- 5. Install purlins over insulation. Nail or screw to the trusses through the bubble insulation
- 6. Install the metal roof to purlins.

Instructions for Top of Purlins (R-Value 6.4):

- 1. Follow instructions above with the exception of installing the bubble insulation AFTER the purlins.
- 2. When installing the bubble insulation, make sure to allow a drape of at least 3/4" between each purlin.
