- **Page 34** Beach Moonflower (*Ipomoea macrantha*) The WA Herbarium have recently changed the botanical name of this plant to *Ipomoea violacea*.
- **Page 129** Coastal Jack Bean (*Canavalia rosea*) The image on this page is not correct for the seed pod and leaves of this plant. - **Page 149** Crocodile Tree (*Terminalia arostrata*) The image on this page is incorrect for *Terminalia arostrata*. The image on page 148 is correct.
- **Page 154** Currant Bush (Carissa spinarum) The WA Herbarium have changed the botanical name of the plant back to Carissa ovata, their reason being that the name Carissa spinarum was misapplied against the bush in Western Australia.
- **Page 188** Western Bloodwood (*Corymbia terminalis*) According to the WA Herbarium and Australian botanist Tim Willing this tree does not occur in Western Australia. The people who submitted sightings of the tree to the Atlas of Living Australia database must have mistaken a similar bloodwood for this tree.
- Page 195 False Cedar (Ehretia saligna) The image on this page is not correct for Ehretia saligna. - Page 242 Grey-leaf Heliotrope (Heliotropium ovalifolium) The WA Herbarium have recently changed the botanical name of this plant to Euploca ovalifolia.
- **Page 308 & 309** Lotus (*Nelumbo nucifera*) According to the WA Herbarium this plant does not occur in Western Australia although Atlas of Living Australia are showing some sightings in waterways around Kalumburu.
- Page 322 Mamukata (Heliotropium tenuifolium) The WA Herbarium have recently changed the botanical name of this plant to Euploca tenuifolia.
- **Pages 336 & 337** Mistletoe (Amyema villiflora) The images on both pages are similar to but not correct for Amyema villiflora.
