

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
# **GENERAL PARTS**



- 1. LED display screen.
- 2. Remote control sensor / Power indicator In standby mode the indicator light is red; when switching on the unit the indicator light is blue colour.
- 3. Stand holder.
- 4. Disc slot To insert a disc according to the silk screen on the side of this slot.
- 5. VOL +/- button- To increase/decrease the volume level or move left/right.
- 6. CH + / To select next channel or move up. / To open or close the disc compartment.
- 7. CH / To select previous channel or move down. / To play or pause playing (DVD).
- 8. MENU button- To enter menu setting page.
- 9. SOURCE button- To select the input source.
- 10. STANDBY button- To turn the TV ON/OFF.

#### REMOTE CONTROL

#### 1. STANDBY

Set the unit in standby mode; press it again to switch it on.

#### 2. TV/RADIO (TV)

Switch the unit between TV and Radio.

#### (DVD)

Load/eject an available disc.

#### 3. RED button (TV)

#### GOTO (DVD)

Start playing from a certain point.

#### 4. GREEN button (TV)

#### ANGLE (DVD)

Change the playing angle, if available.

#### 5. BLUE button (TV)

#### A-B (DVD)

Repeat playing between A and B.

#### 6. YELLOW button (TV)

#### **REPEAT (DVD)**

Change repeat mode.

#### 7. FAV

Display the favorite channels list.

#### 8. TEXT

Display the available Teletext.

#### 9. EPG (TV)

Display electronic program guide.

#### D.MENU (DVD)

Display the main disc menu.

#### **10. HOLD**

Hold the Teletext.

#### **FREEZE**

Hold the picture.

#### 11. SUBTITLE

Enable/disable subtitles.

#### 12. SIZE (TV)

Switch Teletext size.

#### ZOOM (DVD)

Shrink/enlarge the picture.

#### 13. SUBPAGE

Enter Teletext sub-page.

#### 14. ASPECT

Press it repeatedly to select desired screen size.

#### 15. MEDIA

Enter Media (USB) mode directly.

#### 16. ▶Ⅱ

Start/pause playing.

#### **17.** ▶▶

Move fast forward.

#### 18. ◀◀

Move fast backward.


#### 19. **(TV)**

Start RECORDING when watching available digital programs.

#### **D.SETUP (DVD)**

Call out the setup menu.

Stop playing.

Play the next file.

#### INDEX (TV)

Display the record list or Teletext index.

#### 22. |◀◀

Play the previous file.

#### **23. MENU**

Call out the main menu or return to previous menu.

#### 24. AUDIO (TV)

Switch the available soundtrack.

#### LANG (DVD)

Switch the available soundtrack language.

#### 25 OK

Confirm selection.

#### 26. ▲▼◀▶

Navigation buttons

#### **27. SLEEP**

Set desired sleep time.

#### 28. EXIT (TV)

Exit the menu page.

#### TITLE (DVD)

Display the title menu.

#### 29. MUTE

Mute the sound.

#### 30. VOL + | -

Increase/decrease the volume level.

#### 31. CH + | -

Play the next/previous program.

#### 32. DISPLAY

Display the available program information.

#### 33. Number buttons (0-9)

Input the number information, such as channel number and so on.

#### 34. -/--

Switch the digit when watching TV programs.

#### 35. Ҁ⊅

Return to previous channel.

#### 36. SOURCE


Select desired input source.

#### **37. P-MODE**

Switch the picture mode.

#### 38. S-MODE

Switch the sound mode.





#### REMOTE CONTROL PREPARATION

#### **BATTERY INSTALLATION:**

Install the batteries as the following pictures. Be sure + and – terminals are positioned as indicated in the battery compartment (Fig 1).

#### **SERVICE LIFE OF BATTERIES:**

- The batteries typically last for one year although this depends on how often the remote control is used.
- If the remote control fails to work even when it is operated near the player, replace the batteries.
- Use two size AAA dry batteries.

#### **NOTE:**


- Do not drop, step on or otherwise impact the remote control. This may damage the parts or lead to malfunction.
- If the remote control is not going to be used for a long time, remove the batteries.

#### **REMOTE CONTROL OPERATION:**

Point the remote control from no more than about 6m from the remote control sensor and within about 60° of the front of the player (Fig 2).

#### **NOTE:**

- The operating distance may vary according to the brightness of the room.
- Do not point bright light at remote control sensor.
- Do not place objects between the remote control and the remote control sensor.
- Do not use this remote control while simultaneously operating the remote control of any other appliances.






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# **BASIC CONNECTION**


- Insert one end into the power jack on the back of the TV.
- Plug the other end of the adapter into the mains socket.

#### **POWER CONNECTION:**



#### **CONNECT EXTERNAL ANTENNA TO UNIT:**

Install external antenna into antenna jack for best picture.



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# **BASIC CONNECTION (cont.)**


#### **COAXIAL CONNECTION:**

Use a Coaxial cable (not included) to connect the unit with amplifier or other audio decoding devices for audio signal output.



#### **AV CONNECTION:**


For basic connection, use the composite Audio L/R (white/red) and CVBS (yellow) cable to connect the unit with other devices.



# **BASIC CONNECTION (cont.)**

#### **PC/VGA CONNECTION:**


Use VGA cable and Audio cable to connect the unit with TV or PC, and use this product as a monitor.



#### Back of PC

#### **HMDI CONNECTION:**

Use HDMI cable to connect the unit with other devices to receive high-definition multimedia signal.



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

# **BASIC OPERATIONS - DVD PLAYER**

- Ensure equipment and power plug has been connected properly and the unit is set in correct mode before operation.
- Press STANDBY button on the unit or remote control to power ON the unit (indicator will glow blue);
   press it again to power OFF (standby mode) the unit (indicator will glow red).
- Press SOURCE button on the unit or remote control to switch the unit to DVD mode.

#### **BASIC PLAY:**

Press the Power button on the TV or remote control, then press the SOURCE button to select DVD mode. If there is no disc in the DVD player the screen will show "NO DISC". Insert Disc according to picture next to disc slot. Do not touch the playing surface. Hold the disc around the outside with your fingers and place the disc into the slot. The player will automatically draw the disc into the player. To eject the disc, press the EJECT button on the TV or the "  $\triangle$  " button on the remote control.

#### **STOPPING PLAY:**

Press ■ (STOP) button to PRE-STOP. Press ■ (STOP) button again to stop playing NOTE: When player is stopped, the player records the point where STOP was pressed (RESUME function). Press ▶II button again, playback will resume from this point. When the tray is taken out or ■ (STOP) is pressed again, the RESUME function will be cleared.

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


#### **SKIPPING AHEAD OR BACKWARD:**

#### **SKIPPING AHEAD**


During playback, press button to skip to the next chapter (DVD) or a track (Video CD/CD).

#### **SKIPPING BACKWARD**




#### **FAST FORWARD/FAST BACKWARD:**

During playback, press ▶ button or ◀ button to fast forward/backward. Press ▶ II button to resume normal play.



#### PAUSE/PLAY

During playback, press ▶II button to pause playing, press it again to resume normal playback.



#### **MUSIC PLAYBACK:**

- Insert the disc which contains music files and after a few seconds, the screen will show all the folders on the disc.
- Select the folder you want to play by navigation buttons and press the OK button to confirm.
- The files in this folder are displayed and select the desired song by navigation buttons, then press the ▶Ⅱ or OK button to start playback.
- In file selecting page, press ▶▶ or ◄ button to turn to next or previous file.
- Press REPEAT button on remote control to change play mode.
  - Repeat Off: play one file only.
  - Repeat One: repeat one file.
  - Repeat Dir: repeat the files in the folder.
  - Repeat All: repeat all the files.

NOTE: The available repeat modes may vary for different discs.



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#### **MOVIE PLAYBACK:**

- Insert the disc which contains movie files and after a few seconds, the screen will show all the folders on the disc.
- Select the folder you want to play by navigation buttons and press the OK button to confirm.
- The files in this folder are displayed and select the desired file by navigation buttons, then press the II or OK button to start playback.
- During normal playing, press bl or let button, the player will play the next or previous file.
- Press REPEAT button to change play mode.
  - Repeat Off: play one file only.
  - Repeat One: repeat one file.
  - Repeat Dir: repeat the files in the folder.
  - Repeat All: repeat all the files.

**NOTE:** The available repeat modes may vary for different discs.

Press STOP button to return to play list page.



#### JPEG PLAYBACK:

For JPEG picture CD, select the folder you want to play by the navigation buttons and press OK button to confirm. The files in this folder are displayed and select your pictures by using the up/down navigation buttons and press OK button to start playback. Thumbnail of picture will be displayed while you scrolling across the file name. Then press the **II** or OK button to start playback.

**NOTE:** The time of loading and displaying a picture depends on its size. During playback, press the STOP **b** button to return to file selecting page.

- Press REPEAT button to change play mode.
  - Repeat Off: play one file only.
  - Repeat One: repeat one file.
  - Repeat Dir: repeat the files in the folder.
  - Repeat All: repeat all the files.

**NOTE:** The available repeat modes may vary for different discs



#### SKIP TO NEXT/PREVIOUS PICTURE

Press **>>** button to skip to the next picture or **|** dutton to skip to the previous picture. If no key is pressed for 3 seconds, it will skip to next picture automatically.

#### **ROTATING PICTURES**

Press RIGHT navigation button to rotate the picture clockwise. Press LEFT navigation button to rotate the picture counter-clockwise.

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#### **FLIPPING PICTURES**

Press UP navigation button to flip the picture vertically. Press DOWN navigation button to flip the picture horizontally.

#### PICTURE SHRINK/ZOOM

Press ZOOM button repeatedly to enlarge or shrink picture to ZOOM 2, ZOOM 3, ZOOM 4, ZOOM 1/2, ZOOM 1/3, ZOOM 1/4, OFF.

**NOTE:** If the picture is enlarged, you may press navigation buttons to pan across other portions of the picture.

#### **ENJOYING VIDEO CD WITH PLAYBACK CONTROL:**

- When playing VCD 2.0 with PBC, the player will show the VCD version.
- Press D.MENU button on remote control repeatedly to set PBC ON or OFF.
- Press the D.MENU button to switch PBC ON/OFF mode."
- Press number buttons to select corresponding track.
- Example: Track 9, press 0 and 9, several seconds later, it will automatically switch to track 9. Track 15, press -/-- and 5, several seconds later, it will automatically switch to track 15.
- Press ▶▶| or |◀◀ button, the player will play the next or previous track.



#### **VIEWING FROM DIFFERENT ANGLE (DVD ONLY):**

Some DVDs may contain scenes which have been shot simultaneously from a number of different angles. For these discs, the same scene can be viewed from each of these different angles using the ANGLE button.

#### REPEAT PLAY:

Press REPEAT button during playback, it will repeat play one chapter or one title (for DVD disc), or repeat play track (for VCD/CD).

NOTE: Press the D.MENU button to switch PBC OFF mode (for VCD).

#### **A-B REPEAT PLAY**

Repeating sections between two specific points (A-B repeat)

- Press A-B button during playing at the point where repeat play is to be started (A).
- Press A-B button at the point where repeat play is to be ended (B). Repeat play of the selection between points A and B starts.
- Press A-B button again to return to normal play.

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#### GOTO:

Press GOTO button continuously to select the item you want to set and enter a time number, chapter number, track number, etc. Accordingly, the disc will be played from the selected point.

#### **DISPLAY:**


Press DISPLAY button to display the playing status of your disc.

#### **CHANGE SUBTITLE LANGUAGE (DVD ONLY):**

It is possible to change the subtitle language to a different language from the one selected at the initial settings. (This operation works only with discs on which multiple subtitle languages are recorded).

- Press SUBTITLE button during play, the screen will display the current language.
- Press SUBTITLE button again to change language or turn off.

NOTE: When no subtitles are recorded, pressing this button will not work.



#### **ZOOM PLAY:**

This function allows you to enjoy a motion picture. Press ZOOM button when playing, the screen shows: Press navigation button to scroll across the enlarged picture.

#### CHANGING AUDIO SOUNDTRACK LANGUAGE (DVD ONLY):

It is possible to change the audio soundtrack language to a different language from the one selected at the initial settings (This operation works only with discs on which multiple audio soundtrack languages are recorded).

When playing a disc, press LANG button to select desired and available soundtrack language.

NOTE: When no soundtrack languages are recorded, pressing this button will not work

#### **INITIAL SETTINGS:**

Once the initial programming is entered it will be retained in memory until changed, the player can always be operated under the same conditions.

#### **COMMON PROCEDURE FOR INITIAL SETTINGS**

- Press D.SETUP button on remote control.
- Use the navigation buttons to select preferred item, and press OK button, each screen for setting the value is displayed. Then move the navigation buttons to set the item and press OK button to confirm the settings.
- Press D.SETUP button again to close setup menu.
- Use LEFT or RIGHT navigation button to switch to another main setup item. Then press RIGHT or OK button to enter submenu page; press LEFT button to return to previous menu page.

#### 1. GENERAL

**1.1 TV DISPLAY** - It is for selecting TV output mode.

Available options:

- 4:3 PanScan
- 4:3 Letterbox
- 16:9

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- **1.2 OSD LANGUAGE** It is used to choose your desired OSD language.
- **1.3 SCREEN SAVER** If no operation is carried out for 5 minutes, screen saver will display on the screen when SCREEN SAVER is ON.
- **1.4 LAST MEMORY** Enter another input source during DISC playback, and then back to DVD input source again, this unit will resume playback from the point where last playback was stopped, if LAST MEMORY is ON.



#### 2. AUDIO

**SPEAKER SETUP** - It is used to select desired audio output mode.

Available options:

- STEREO
- MONO L/R
- MIX MONO



#### 3. PREFERENCE

- **3.1 TV SYSTEM** Select desired TV system.
- 3.2 PASSWORD Change the password. Input the password using number buttons on remote control.

**NOTE:** The factory default password is "0000", you can change it, but you should keep it safe. If you forget it, please use the universal password "4711".

- 3.3 PARENTAL Exchange the location of "PARENTAL" and "PASSWORD"
- 3.4 DEFAULT It is used to reset to factory settings.



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#### **BASIC OPERATIONS - TV**

#### **NAVIGATION PRINCIPLES IN THE MENU:**

- Press the MENU button on the remote control to display the main menu.
- Press ▲▼◀▶ to select different menus or settings.
- Press the OK button to enter the sub-menu.
- Press the MENU button to save the settings and return to the previous page.
- Press the EXIT button to exit the menu.

#### **BASIC APPLICATIONS:**

- Press the POWER button on remote control to turn on the power. Press this button again to put the TV on standby.
- Press the SOURCE button on remote control to switch between the different sources available.

#### **SELECTING THE DESIRED PROGRAM:**

- Press the CH + button to switch to the next channel.
- Press the CH button to switch to the previous channel.
- Press the numeric buttons to directly select the desired channel. Press the SOURCE button on remote control to switch between the different sources available.

#### **VOLUME CONTROL:**

- Press the VOL+ or VOL- button to adjust the volume level.
- Press the MUTE button to mute the sound and press it again to restore it.

#### **SELECTING THE SOURCE:**

- Press the SOURCE button to display the list of available sources.
- Press UP/DOWN buttons to select the source and press the OK button to confirm.

#### **VIDEO SIZE SETTING:**

- Press the ASPECT button on the remote control repeatedly to select the VIDEO SIZE directly.
   Available options:
  - Auto
  - 4:3
  - 16:9
  - Zoom1
  - Zoom2

NOTE: The available video size may be different for different input sources.

#### **MULTI-AUDIO SETTING:**

Press the AUDIO button on the remote control repeatedly to select the desired audio language.

NOTE: To enable this function, make sure that the channel you are viewing supports multi-audio languages.

#### **INFORMATION DISPLAY:**

Press the DISPLAY button on the remote control to display information of current programs.

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#### FIRST-TIME INSTALLATION:

#### 1. TUNING SETUP

Connect to power source and turn on this TV, logo page will display on the screen.

Press UP/DOWN navigation buttons on remote control to select the language to be used for menus and message.

Press OK button on remote control to confirm selection.




#### 2. COUNTRY/REGION

Press UP/DOWN navigation buttons on remote control to select the country/region. Press OK button on remote control to confirm selection.



#### 3. ANTENNA TYPE

Press UP/DOWN navigation buttons on remote control to select Air/Cable. Press OK button on remote control to confirm selection.




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
#### 4. AUTO SEARCH

Press UP/DOWN navigation buttons on remote control to select All, ATV, DTV. Press OK button on remote control to confirm selection.



#### TV GUIDE (FOR TV MODE ONLY):

- Press the EPG button on the remote control to display the program guide.
- Press the UP/DOWN navigation button to select a preferred program.
- Press the LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to switch between the left column and right column.
- Press RED button on remote control to switch between Daily and Weekly programme.
- Press GREEN button on remote control to select desired Remind mode, when the cursor is on the right column.
- Press YELLOW button on remote control to display program guide of previous day.
- Press BLUE button on remote control to display program guide of next day.





#### **FAVOURITE LIST:**

- When viewing an available channel, press FAV button on remote control to enter Favourite List menu page.
- Press UP or DOWN navigation button to select preferred channel.
- Press OK button to confirm selection.



#### **QUICK SELECT:**

- Press OK button on remote control to enter Channel List page directly.
- Press UP or DOWN navigation button to select desired channel and press OK button to watch it.
- Press OK button to confirm selection.



#### **TELETEXT:**

 Press the TEXT button on the remote control to display the available teletext information and press it repeatedly to stop playing the teletext.

Nothing in this warranty is to be interpreted as excluding, restricting or modifying any State or Federal legislation applicable to the supply of goods and services which cannot be excluded, restricted or modified.

If you are a consumer as defined in the Australian Consumer Law: Our goods come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law. You are entitled to a replacement or refund for a major failure and compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage. You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced if the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure.

#### Warranty
