## **SIGNCRYL**

## **Description**

A fast drying thermoplastic acrylic lacquer especially formulated for the sign industry. The product has a high gloss off the gun and exhibits excellent adhesion to acrylic and polycarbonate sheeting. Exterior durability is excellent.

### Uses

Suitable for spraying acrylic and polycarbonate sheeting for interior, exterior illuminated signs. It also can be used to coat colourbond and weathertex and metals and to coat cast vinyl.

## **Application**

THINNING Reduce with adjusting clear as required then thin between 100 to

150% with the recommended Signcryl thinner.

SPRAYING VISCOSITY 13 - 14 seconds B4 cup @ 25 deg. C.

SPRAY GUN SETUP Type: Conventional Air Atomised

Fluid Tip: 1.5 - 2.0 mm

Airpressure: 200 - 400 KPa (30 - 60 psi.)

APPLICATION Apply 2 - 4 single wet coats allowing 3 - 5 minutes between

coats at 25 degC.

DRY FILM THICKNESS Approximately 15 microns per coat.

DRYING TIME Dust Free: 5 minutes Tack Free: 15 minutes AT 25 degC Dry to Handle: 30 minutes Hard Dry: 4 hours

Dry Polish: 24 hours

TAPING Remove after 15 - 20 minutes

RETAPE / RECOAT 20 minutes

## Clean Up

Use Signcryl Thinner

500 ml, 1 litre, 4 litre, 20 litre.

Colour card and colour matching

### TYPICAL COATING SYSTEMS

### 1. POLYCARBONATE SHEETING

Use Signcryl 100 thinners only. Other thinners may cause stress cracking

## 2. ACRYLIC SHEETING and CAST VINYL

Use Signcryl 100 or 200 thinners

## 3. COLOURBOND/ WEATHERTEX

Use Signcryl 200 thinners

## 4. PETG SHEETING - SOLAREX and VIVAC

Use Signcryl 350 thinners for best adhesion

**Surface Preparation** Solvent wipe with appropriate Signcryl thinner to remove all oil,

grease, and finger prints etc. Wipe with Tak rag to remove dust.

**Thinning** Reduce with adjusting clear as required then thin between 100

to 150% with the appropriate Signcryl thinner.

**Application** Apply even wet coats to desired coverage/transparency.
