

## **Beaded Daisy Chain**



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**DIFFICULTY: Intermediate** 

Approximate time of project: 1 hour

## **MATERIALS**

Sullivans seed beads in an assortment of colours Sullivans clear nylon beading thread Sullivans true barrel clasps Scissors

## **STEPS**

- Pick beads in three different colours for the:
  - Chain
  - Petals
  - Flower centres
- Cut your beading thread. For a bracelet, cut enough to fit around your wrist with some extra to tie to the clasp. For a necklace, cut a longer strand
- Attach one half of the clasp by tieing a double knot through it
- Begin to thread your beads in the following order:
  - 4 chain beads
  - 4 petal beads
  - 1 flower centre bead
- Guide the thread back through the first petal bead and pull gently to tigthen
- String on 3 more petal beads
- Guide the thread back through the petal bead under the centre bead and pull tightly again
- You've just made your first daisy flower in the chain!
- Simply repeat until you achieve the length you desire
- Attach the other half of the clasp and trim the excess thread to give a neat finish
