Bees Wax Wraps

how to make

Bees Wax Wraps

DIFFICULTY

Easy - Approx. 30 minutes

MATERIALS

30cm x 30cm Cream/bees fabric 25cm x 25cm Blue/sky butterflies 20cm x 20cm White/mixed birds and bees Arbee Candle making beeswax pellets

EOUIPMENTS

Iron/Ironing board Baking paper 2 pieces Towel Cardboard **Pinking Shears**

STEPS

- 1. Measure and cut squares of fabrics using pinking shears in various sizes.
- 2. Lay down a towel and a piece of cardboard. Place baking paper and fabric square on top with right side facing upwards.
- 3. Sprinkle beeswax pallets over the fabric square and cover with another piece of baking paper.
- 4. Carefully iron over the top until the beeswax has melted and has covered the entire piece of fabric.
- 5. Allow to slightly cool. Peel off baking paper and fabric. Be careful it may be hot.

NOTE

Do not use with raw meat or fish.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Wash with lukewarm water. Keep away from hot surfaces. Do not soak. Store in dry place. Make sure dishes have cooled down before wrapping.
