Macrame Plant Hanger

Easy

### DIFFICULTY

Easy - Approx. 1 hour

### MATERIALS

- Tie Dye
- Makr macrame cord opal white
- Arbee wood macrame ring bead large
- Arbee wood beads square
- Arbee wood round 30mm assorted x 2 packets

### EQUIPMENTS

- Scissors
- Bucket
- Water
- Sticky tape

### STEPS

1. Wet 2 x 70cm cords for tie dye. Follow your dyeing instructions. Dye cords in rainbow. Let dry.
2. Add 3 x 2 meter macrame cord to the wooden ring bead.
3. Secure with rainbow gathering knot. Place the top of the rainbow cord onto the ring and create a loop. While holding tight wrap the cord around the other cords. Take the tail end of the cord and pull it all the way through the loop. While holding the bottom cord pull the top cord tightly which is going to secure the cord. Trim off the ends and push them in with a pair of scissors.
4. Sticky tape the ends of two cords together and slide a square bead on. Tie a knot under it. Do the same for the other cords.
5. Take a cord from either side and tie a knot. Do the same for the others.
6. Secure the bottom with a rainbow gathering knot.
7. Sticky tape the ends of the cords to make it easier to slide beads on. Slide coloured beads on all cords and tie a knot. Trim the bottom.
