## Blanket Finger Knitting

Intermediate

### DIFFICULTY

Intermediate - Approx. 3 Hour

### MATERIALS

- Makr Thick and Chunky  
Lilac Haze It purple yarn x 3

### EQUIPMENT

- Scissors

### STEPS

1. Begin chain by making a slip knot. Create a loop over your hand, then feed working yarn back through the loop and pull through.
2. Pinch through the centre and pull a loop through the chain. Chain 35. Try and keep the loops even in size.
3. Pick the first loop from the first chain and pull a loop through the chain. Continue to the end.
4. Repeat rows. Knit 60 rows.
5. To tie 2 skeins together use a magic knot. Lay both yarns parallel to each other. Take the left yarn and loop it over the right yarn and knot it. Repeat on the other side. Pull the long ends and the two knots will create a double knot. Trim the tails.
6. Cast off by threading the second loop into the first loop and then the third loop into the second loop and continue this process until you reach the end. When you reach the end tie a knot. Take the tail end and thread it to the final loop and just weave the tail through the blanket.
