



BIG FUN Blanket

EASY KNIT

Create an impressive result with this Big Fun patchwork blanket pattern by simply knitting two-tone individual squares and joining them together. The squares are made with an intarsia knitting technique for colour changing, by twisting yarn threads over each other in the back of the knitting. This is the perfect home décor project as it can be knitted up in just a day or two with our Thicck & Chunky yarn, and big needles. Adapt the blanket size to your needs by adding or reducing the amount of squares to the width or length.

MEASUREMENTS

Length	60cm	180cm

YARN REQUIRED

Makr THICCK and CHUNKY Yarn 500g balls

Lilac Haze	2	
Seude Brown	2	
Spice Mix	2	
Dusk Orange	2	
Sea Spay	2	

NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY • • •

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

25mm knitting needles

TENSION:

25mm: 9sts x $12rows = 10cm \times 10cm$ stst.

KNITTING ABBREVIATION:

C: colour
K: knit
P: purl
St(s): stitch(es)

COLOUR CHART

Following the sequence of the Colour Diagram on page 2, the colours in the pattern will be represented by a First Colour (C1) and a Second Colour (2)

BLANKET PATTERN

SQUARES

Cast on 20 sts with First Colour (C1)

Row 1. K 20 C1

Row 2. Join C2 and P2, C1 P18

Row 3. C1 K18, C2 K2

Row 4. C2 P3, C1 P17

Row 5. C1 K16, C2 K4

Row 6. C2 P5, C1 P15

Row 7. C1 K14, C2 K6

Row 8. C2 P7, C1 P13

Row 9. C1 K12, C2 K8

Row 10. C2 P9, C1 P11 Row 11. C1 K10, C2 K10

NOW 11. CT K10, C2 K10

Row 12. C2 P11, C1 P9

Row 13. C1 K8, C2 K12 Row 14. C2 P13, C1 P7

Row 15. C1 K6, C2 K14

Row 16. C2 P15, C1 P5

Row 17. C1 K 4, C2 K16

Row 18. C2 P17, C1 P3

Row 19. C1 K2, C2 K18

Row 20. C2 P19, C1 K1

C2 K Cast off with Second Colour

TO FINISH

Join squares by using hands and fingers to weave threads through the cast off and cast on edges of the squares.
