











NOW TRACE THE CORD FOR THE SECOND ROUND, SO THAT 2 CORDS SIT SIDE BY SIDE, UNTIL THE END AND START FACE EACH OTHER. TIE THESE TOGETHER, TUCKING IN LOOSE THREADS TO NEATEN









Knot Cushion

EASY KNIT

Make this chic knot cushion pattern by knitting a long tube with the i-cord technique, then follow the steps to cleverly wind it around itself to form a knot. Made with our super Chunky Sherpa yarn and big needles, it is a quick and gratifying project and is the perfect cuddling size for your sofa or bed décor.

MEASUREMENTS

ONE SIZE	
Approx Width	25cm
Approx Height	22cm

YARN REQUIRED

2

Makr CHUNKY SHERPA Yarn 226g balls

NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY • • •

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

25mm straight knitting needles

TENSION:

25mm: $3sts \times 4rows = 10cm \times 10cm stst$

KNITTING ABBREVIATION:

K knit stitch(es) St(s)

KNOT CUSHION PATTERN

Cast on 3 sts.

K row.

*Slide sts off left needle and place on right needle with knit side facing.

Draw the thread from the left side towards the right hand side and knit row.*

Repeat for approximately 4m length.

Follow pictures to wind cord into knot pillow form.

TO FINISH

Tuck threads in to neaten. Gently correct the tension of the cords and pat to form the pillow into a cube.
