Sunglass Case



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DIFFICULTY

Easy - Approx. 30 minutes

MATERIALS

Craft Fabric Yellow Cotton Bathing Matching Thread

EOUIPMENTS

- Sewing Machine
- **Fabric Scissors**
- Iron / Ironing Board

STEPS

1. Cut all fabrics to size: Outside - 18cm x 20cm Lining - 18cm x 24cm Batting 18cm x 18cm

- 2. Place the outside fabric and lining right sides together. Place the batting on top and pin. Sew 2 ½ cm seam allowance, this will be the brim of the sunglass case.
- 3. Iron the seam flat. Flip the lining on to the back and align the bottom edges and iron flat.
- 4. Align the 2 seams right sides together. Pin in place. Sew along the edges leaving a 8cm gap for turning. Don't sew directly on the batting. The batting is shorter than the fabric to reduce the bulk.
- 5. Trim corners. Turn right side out. Sew lining close.
- 6. Iron flat and tuck lining inside sunglass case.
