To prolong the life of the product and retain its appearance and functionality, we would like to give you some relevant information and care advice:-

This unit is manufactured with either oak, black stained oak or walnut.

Craftsmen manufacture this product and there is variety between each unit. This is because wood is a natural product, with natural colour and grain variations.

Natural timber is affected by sunlight; this can can the wood colour to darken. For this reason (especially if placed in direct sunlight) it is recommended that placing objects in the same position for long periods of time is avoided. This potential colour adjustment becomes less relevant as the product ages.

It is recommended that no abrasive cleaners or solvents are used to clean the unit. Please only use proprietary furniture polishes or alternatively, warm water with a diluted mild detergent.

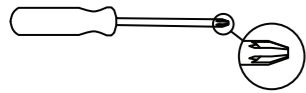

Cross Round Table

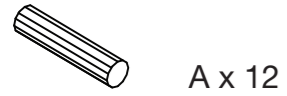

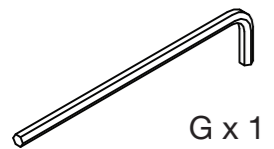

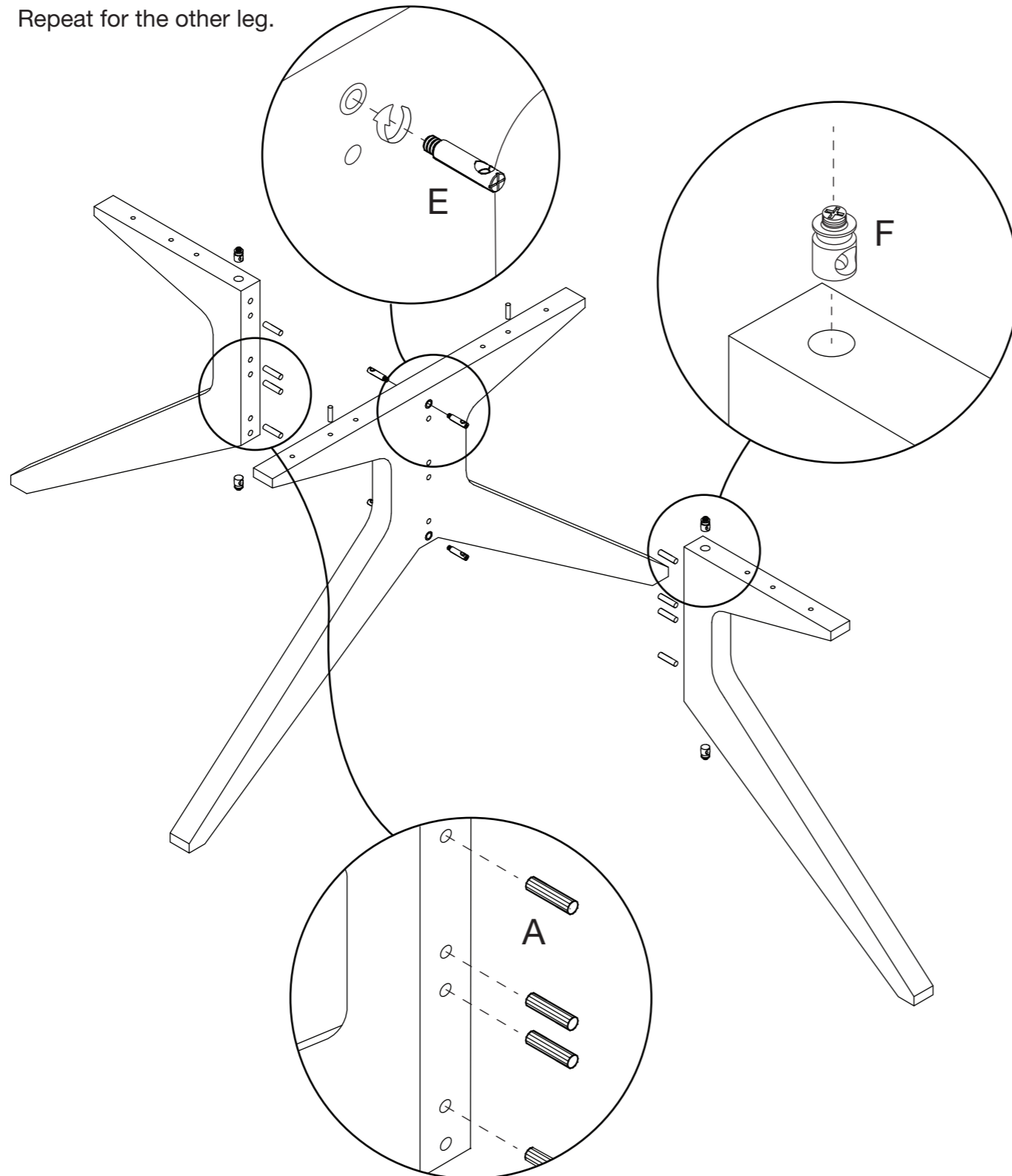
Step 1.

Place the central leg section onto one side and attach fittings E into the two outer threaded holes. Insert fitting A into the remaining holes.

Insert fittings F into the top and bottom of the each other leg, ensuring the hole in the side of the fitting is clear and correctly aligned with the hole in the leg, into which fittings E locate.

Push the leg onto the fittings and once it is in place and level tighten fitting F with a screwdriver.

Repeat for the other leg.



Step 2.

With the table top facing down, fully insert wooden dowels A to help locate the assembled base.

Once the base is correctly in place, insert fittings C into the inner bolt holes and fittings D into the outer.

Fully tighten with allen key G.

With at least two people, turn the table onto its feet ensuring the legs clear the floor until fully upright.
